No Special Reason Given But Roman Catholics Are Alleged to Be Back of Move.

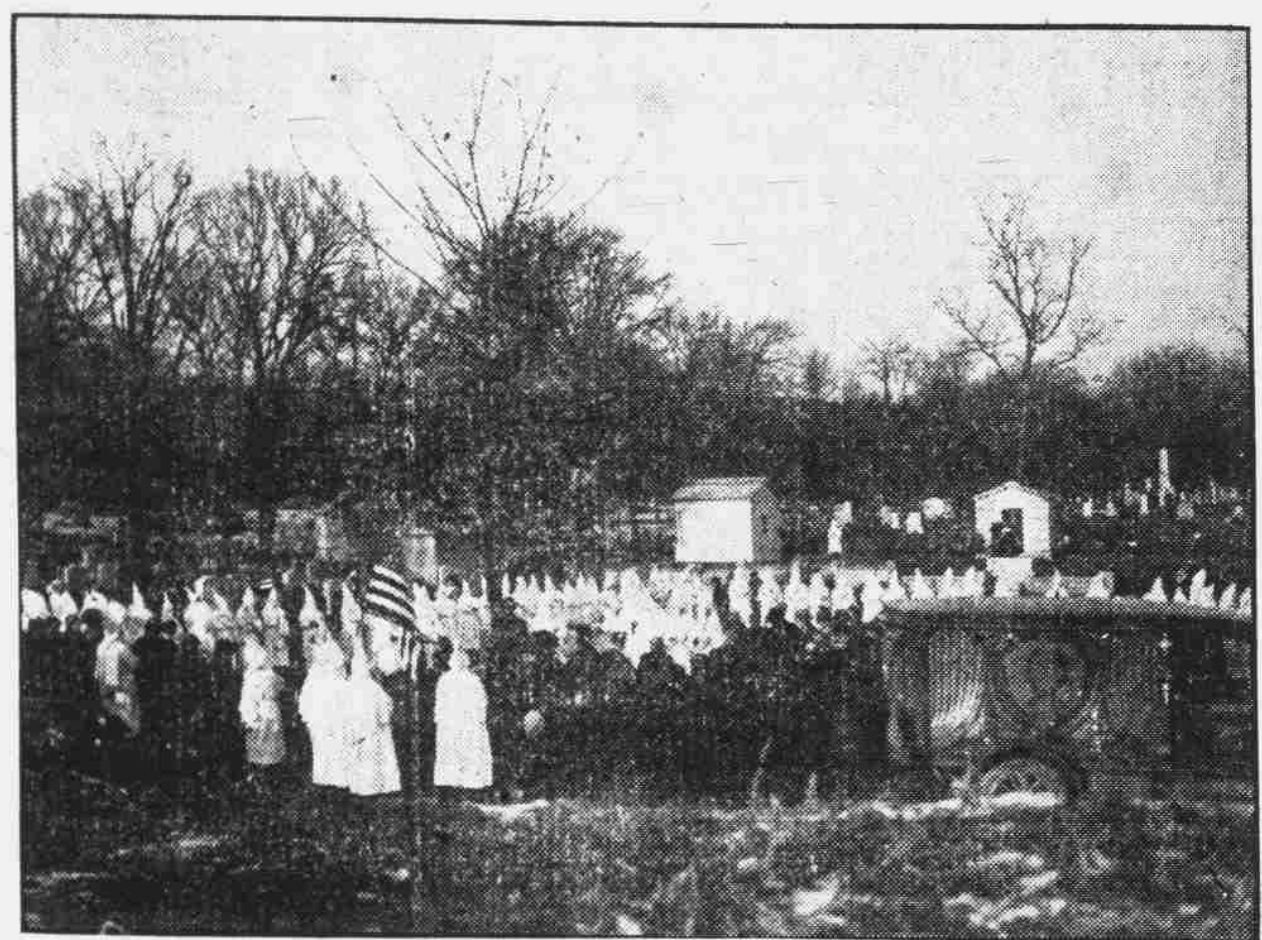
(Special to The Kourier.) El Paso, Tex., Jan. 19.—A telegram ordering municipal authorities to close a federal school in the Jaurez District has been received by Mayor P. M. Plerro from the state secretary of education. As a result 250 pupils are turned out of school.

Efforts to have the state government finance the school are being made. Although no reason was given for closing the school it is supposed it is in line with general re-enforcement. Several other schools have been closed within the state it reported. This action is in line with prediction made several weeks ago that the Roman Catholic machine was beginning to operate and would use its influence to close the public schools as far as possible.

MEXICAN MINERS ARE DRINKING HALF TIME. (Special to The Kourier.) Albuquerque, N. M., Jan. 19.—Mr. R. E. Farley, Secretary of the anti-slavery movement in New Mexico, has returned from Nacznari, Mexico, which is located near the American border. Mr. Farley was invited to make a survey of the Mexican town by officials of a large mining company operating there, looking to relief from the whiskey men. He stated that mining officials advised him a great many of their men working in the mines were putting in only three days a week, the remainder of their time being taken up in drinking. It is planned to send a Spanish speaking anti-slavery worker to the town in a campaign to be started soon.
