NOTICE TO BIDDERS

Bids will be accepted either for the complete units or for the bodies and chassis separately. Said bodies and chassis must meet the specifications of the Indiana School Bus Committee as set forth in Bulletin 260. The bid should include the following items: Direction Signal Switch, Vacuum Gauge, 100 Amp. Generator, Front Shock absorbers, Vacuum Tank and 9:20 Tires. Please bid the following optional bids: Power Steering, 5 Speed Transmission and Larger engine.
