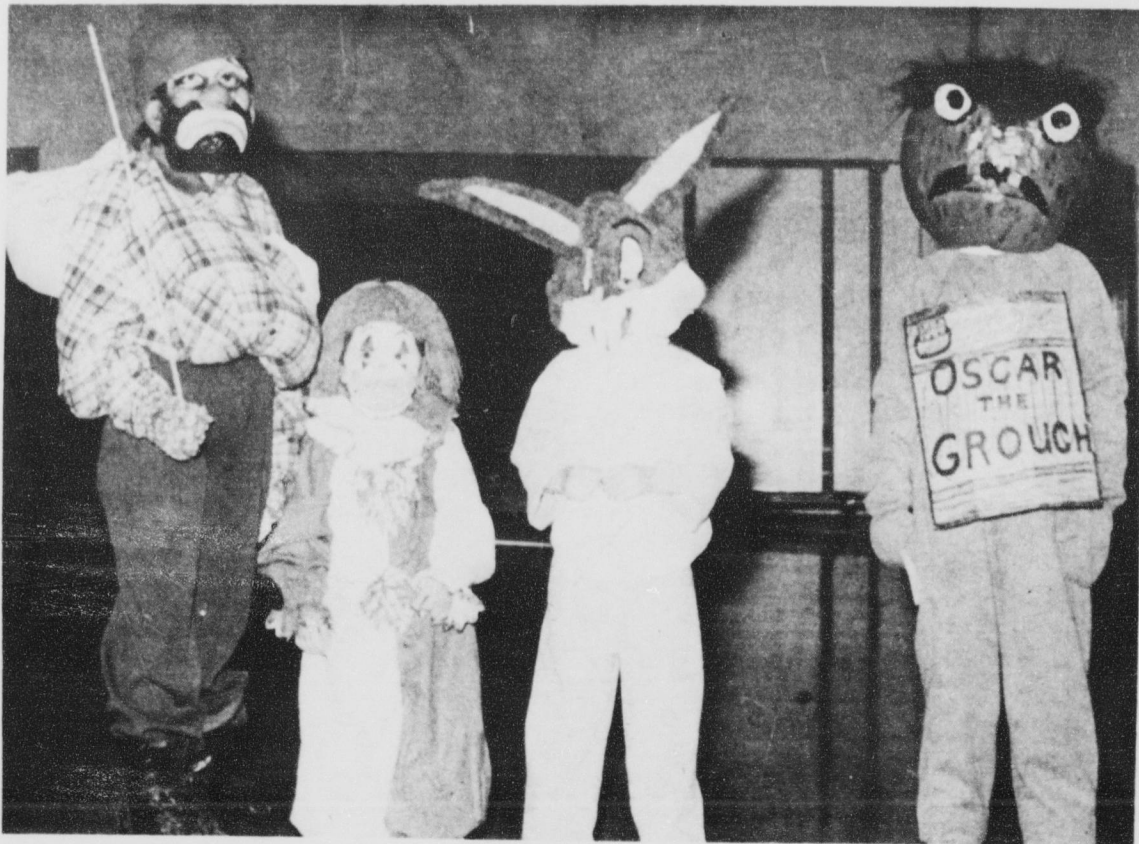


HALLOWEEN COSTUME WINNERS

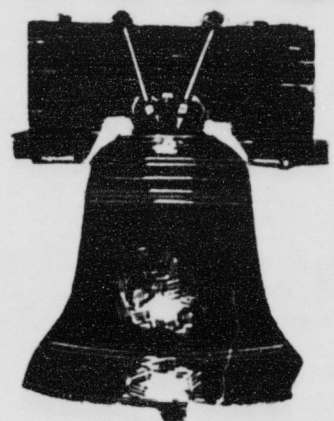

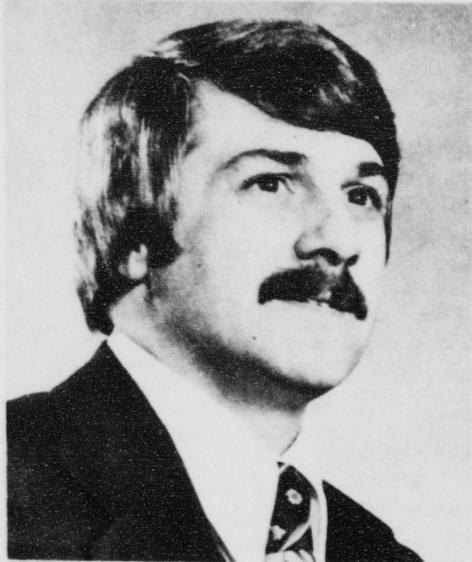
