

Falcons Win

drop the football and have to go back and get it. On this play the senior tailback solidly went over the 1,000 yard mark for the season as he had hovered right around that mark until breaking this 20 yarder. A Jeff Fansler to Tinkey pass picked up 14 more and three other plays had only generated one yard when on a third and 10 at the mid-field stripe O'Connor took a hand-off and found a gapping hole in the right side of the line, broke through and raced 50 yards for the second score. This time Phelps didn't get the kick up and it was no good, but the Falcons led 13-0 with 7:54 left in the first half.

Glenn recovered a Redskin fumble on the kickoff with Mike Elkin covering another loose ball caused by a hard Boise hit, but two plays later Glenn returned the ball on a Tinkey fumble on a wide sweep. Three more possessions were quickly witnessed as neither team could sustain a drive until a fairly short punt by Knox fielded by Tinkey gave Glenn the ball first and 10 at their own 48 with time running short. After a six yard run by O'Connor, Fansler hit Phelps for 11 yards and on the next play a wide pitchout to flanker Tinkey found him lofting a long pass to an all-alone Mike Aitken behind the Knox defense and the junior tight end gathered the ball in for the touchdown with just :19 showing on the clock. Phelps kicked another good point and it was 20-0 at the main intermission.

After a rather lengthy halftime ceremony, play was halted early in the third quarter as the Knox quarterback, Doug Biddle, suffered a knee injury on the first play from scrimmage. He was finished for the night and after play resumed, a couple of plays later Phelps recovered another Redskin fumble at the Glenn 41 and after Tinkey gained

10 on the first down, a fumble was recovered by Fansler before he dropped back and lofted another long pass into the hands of Aitken racing down the field behind the Knox secondary. He pulled this in and ran the rest of the way for the game's final score, a 49 yard overall play. Phelps kicked true again and it was 27-0.

Knox never penetrated inside the Falcon 40 yard line after this and with reserves getting more action, it was just a matter of time.

Once again not enough can be said for the defense of Glenn which really held the Redskins at bay. It was a great team effort on defense, time and time again holding the Redskins to no gain or throwing them for losses on several plays. On offense, it was another 100 plus night for O'Connor, with 124 in 21 carries to raise his season total to 1,104 in nine games. The passing attack looked more diversified also, gaining 130 yards through the air.

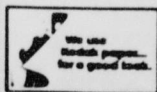
