

SAYS LEAGUE EXPANDS MONROE DOCTRINE IDEA

F. D. ROOSEVELT MAKES THREE ADDRESSES AT TERRE HAUTE.

ASSAILS HARDING'S RECORD

TERRE HAUTE, Ind., October 14.—Franklin D. Roosevelt, Democratic vice-presidential nominee, made three addresses before large audiences in Terre Haute Wednesday evening. In his principal speech, at the Courthouse, he said that James Monroe, father of the Monroe Doctrine, was in reality the author of the league of nations. He said the league plan is an expansion of the Monroe Doctrine. "I wish to take you back ninety-nine years," said Mr. Roosevelt. "To the time when James Monroe gave to the world a new theory. To the south of us was a little nation independent only by the force of our arms. It looked to us for protection, and not in vain. "If Monroe were alive today he would no more accept a substitute for the league guaranteeing those countries against aggression of stronger nations than at that time. Right Against Might. "Monroe's doctrine was founded on Christian morals—right against might. That's been the history of big nations. There are forty-one nations in the league, forty-one out of a possible forty-seven, and those forty-one are in it because they have not been telling lies and falsehoods about the league as we have. "Only a few days ago Senator Harding said the league was a monumental fraud, and as the words were leaving his lips over the wire was coming the message that Sweden and Finland, on the verge of war, had decided to submit their difficulties to the council. "Compares Public Records. "Mr. Roosevelt contrasted the public records of the two presidential nominees. "They're history," he said, "and you have a right to read history. That other gentleman from Ohio (referring to Senator Harding) was the right hand man of Penrose, Watson, Smoot, Lodge and Foraker, the latter affectionately known as Standard Oil Joe. "Senator Harding once referred to Theodore Roosevelt as a 'second Benedict Arnold.' Some members of the Roosevelt family will not forget that in a hurry. He has always been against progressive things. He would have blocked the federal reserve bill, which took the country's finance out of the hands of Wall street. He opposed the child labor laws, and the workmen's compensation act. "Look at what Cox has done in Ohio along those very lines," said Mr. Roosevelt. "I need not tell you." (Special to The Indianapolis News) GREENCASTLE, Ind., October 13.—Franklin D. Roosevelt, Democratic candidate for Vice-President, in an address here Wednesday afternoon said that in the last several days he has received messages from various parts of the country to the effect that the voters are flocking to the Democratic party standard because of the party's advocacy of the league of nations. He urged support of Governor James M. Cox, the party's candidate for President, "because Governor Cox has a definite foreign policy while the Republicans offer nothing."

Many Women In Audience. (Special to The Indianapolis News) BRAZIL, Ind., October 14.—Franklin D. Roosevelt, Democratic nominee for Vice-President, urged Clay county voters to voice their approval of the league of nations in an address he made here yesterday afternoon in his tour of Indiana. He spoke to a large audience in a garage building, fully half of his hearers being women. Homer S. Cummings, formerly Democratic national chairman, spoke here Wednesday evening. In the afternoon Hiking Hiram Beane, of Peru, formerly a colonel in the marine corps, and Lewis Kistner, of New York, spoke for the Republicans.

Two Pay Death Penalty. Italian and Negro Hanged in Cook County (Illinois) Jail. CHICAGO, June 14.—Frank Campione, Italian, and James Reese, negro, were hanged simultaneously in the Cook county jail here today. Reese protested his innocence to the last. Campione broke down as the noose was slipped around his neck. Reese was convicted of murdering his wife and Campione of killing a man in a holdup. Ten other men sentenced to be hanged here tomorrow for the murder of another negro woman. Her sentence was commuted to life imprisonment. No woman has been hanged in the District of Columbia since the execution of Mrs. Surratt in connection with the Lincoln assassination.

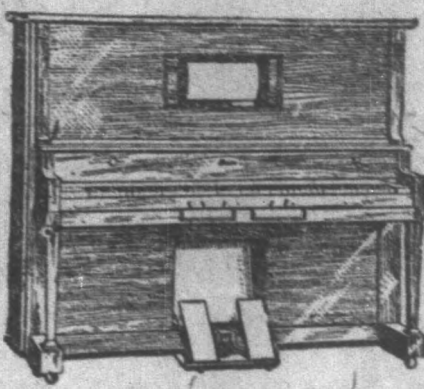

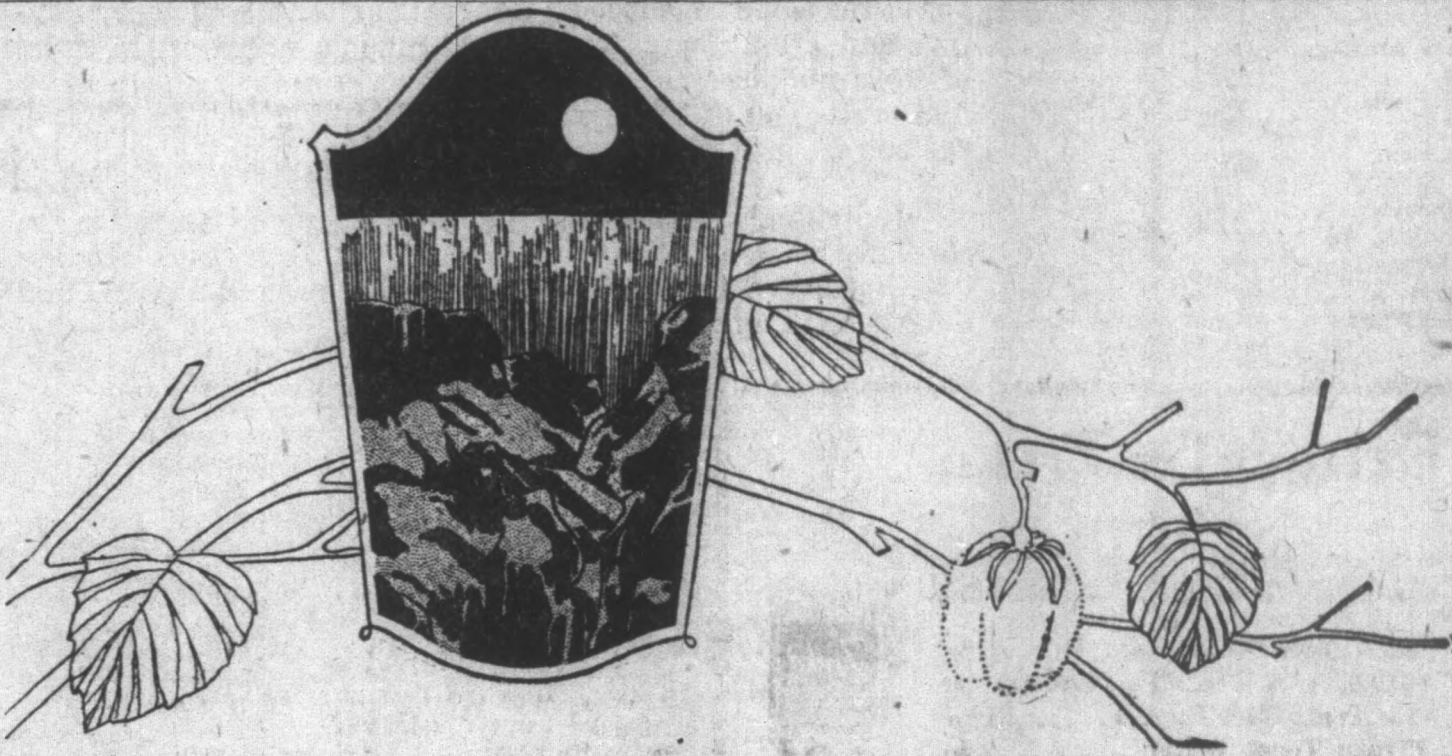

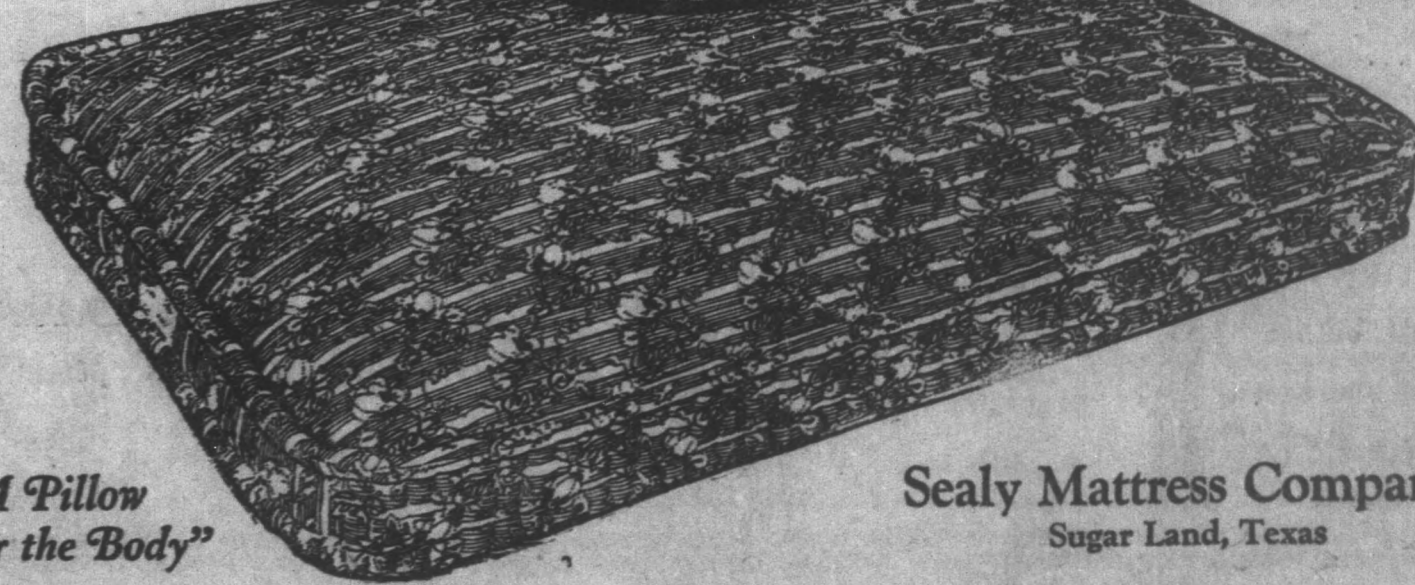
