PURDUE MEDALS TO GO TO INDIVIDUAL STARS

CITY ALUMNI TO ENCOURAGE HIGH SCHOOL FOOTBALL BY AWARDS.

AN all-Indianapolis high school football team to consist of eleven regulars and four substitutes will be chosen each year under auspices of the Purdue University Alumni Association of the city and county. The players selected on this team will receive what is to be called the Purdue medal. The medal has been taken by the Purdue Alumni Association in order to encourage playing of football in Indianapolis, and the plan has received the consent of the officials at each of the high schools.

This all-Indianapolis team will be chosen with the following points in mind:

1. Natural ability as a football player.
 2. The season's record of the player as a member of the team to which he belongs.
 3. The willingness and ability of the player to work for the success of the team.
 4. The player's character and ability.
- The substitutes may be chosen from the players who have been written out because it is considered that the selection of some one player for a position on the team will be more than offset by the loss of another player who has been written out because of some other player whose record entitles him to equal or better position.

Makeup of Committee.

The above team shall be chosen as soon as possible after the close of the football season by a committee to be made up as follows:

The chairman of the committee, who shall preside at all meetings but shall not be entitled to a vote, shall be the president of the Purdue Alumni Association of Indianapolis.

Each high school shall be represented by the manager of the football team and by one other representative, to be selected by the principal of the school.

Each of the three leading daily papers, The Indianapolis News, the Indianapolis Star and the Indianapolis Daily Times, shall be represented by the sports editor or his representative.

This committee shall make such additional rules and regulations for its guidance as may be necessary.

MAY RUN IN ENGLAND

WINDSOR, Ontario, October 14.—Man o' War, the greatest horse of the century, will probably run in England. This wonderful piece of horseflesh may carry the Glen Riddle colors in the Ascot Gold Cup, this year.

The idea of sending Man o' War abroad was discussed by Sam Riddle and the party that came here to witness the triumph of the great horse over Sir Barton.

All but Riddle voted to send Man o' War across the sea. Finally he capitulated, and then on the proposition up to his trainer, Fustel, the latter was willing, so it looks now as if the wonder horse will seek new fields in which to display his marvelous speed and energy.

The Ascot Gold Cup is run in July, so Man o' War would leave here for several months. While away, he has such a strong pride in his pet that he is anxious to win the race and bring home the honors. For that reason alone the invasion of Britain by this great horse is next to certain.
