

**125 INDICTED
IN COURT MAY 4**

You filed citing striking coal miners for contempt under the federal injunction. Evidence of violation of the Lever act was said to have first been discovered by the department of justice in 1919 during investigations made in the war period. Representatives of the department have been making investigations of the coal industry for the last two years and concentrated their efforts on the central competitive field during the coal strike of last year.

Charges in the indictment returned yesterday were based on the following sections of the Lever act and the criminal code:

Section 2 of the act of Oct. 22, 1919,

amending section 4 of the Lever act—"That it is hereby made unlawful for any person wilfully to destroy any necessary for the purpose of enhancing the price or restricting the supply thereof; knowingly to commit waste or wilfully to permit preventable deterioration of any necessities in or in connection with their production, manufacture or distribution; to hoard, as defined in section 6 of this act, any necessities; to monopolize or attempt to monopolize, either locally or generally, any necessities; to engage in any discriminatory and unfair, or any deceptive or wasteful practice or device, or to make any unjust or unreasonable rate or charge in handling or dealing with any necessities; to conspire, combine, agree or arrange with any other person (a) to limit the facilities for transporting, producing, harvesting, manufacturing, supplying, storing or dealing

in any necessities; (b) to restrict the supply of any necessities; (d) to prevent, limit or lessen the manufacture or production of any necessities in order to enhance the price thereof; or (e) to exact excessive prices for any necessities; or to aid or abet the doing of any act made unlawful by the provisions of this section."

Section 9 of the Lever act—"That any person who conspires, combines, agrees or arranges with any other person (a) to limit the facilities for transporting, producing, manufacturing, supplying, storing or dealing in any necessities; (b) to restrict the supply of any necessities; (c) to restrict the distribution of any necessities; (d) to prevent, limit or lessen the manufacture or production of any necessities, in order to enhance the price thereof shall, upon conviction thereof, be fined not exceeding \$10,000, or

be imprisoned for not more than two years, or both."

Section of the Criminal Code—"If two or more persons conspire either to commit any offense against the United States, or to defraud the United States in any manner or for any purpose, and one or more of such parties do any act to effect the object of the conspiracy, each of the parties to such conspiracy shall be fined not more than \$10,000, or imprisoned not more than two years, or both."
