

## HIGHER TREND TO STOCK LIST

Foreign News Ignored, While  
Traders Bid Up Prices.

NEW YORK, March 13.—There were many mixed movements at the opening of the stock market today, although the general trend was still upward, and part of the market was more or less steady. Foreign news discounted and the market soon turned strong. Profit taking usual to week-end trading developed, but values up well and market closed steady.

The motor shares were the most prominent issues, Chandler Motor yielding 1/2 to 14/16, and Peerless 15/16. General Motors, after yielding 4 points to 18, had a quick recovery to 23. Studebaker yielded to 96 1/2, a loss of 8%, but soon recovered this loss.

Standard Oil of New Jersey 1/2 to 95/16 and Baldwin Locomotive, after yielding 1/2 to 117 1/2, rose to 124. Crucible was off 1 point at 122. Republic Steel, gold 100, advanced 20 to 102 1/2. Pudding Advanced 23 to 89 1/2. Texas & Pacific was in demand, advancing 1/2 to 45 1/2, while gains of 1 point were made in Southern Pacific and New Haven.

Mexican Petroleum rose 2 points to 103 1/2. Pan-American Petroleum dropped 1/2 to 83 1/2 and Standard Oil of Texas company was up 1 point at 108.

The market closed steady. Most of the leading issues rose to new high records for the day, and trading on which looked to be short covering.

Steel common rose to a closing of 99, and Baldwin was 1 1/2 higher at 123. Standard Oil of New Jersey advanced 10 points from its low to 241. Pan-American Petroleum was 1 point higher at 93 1/2, and U. S. Rubber was 2 points above 100. Republic Steel advanced nearly 2 points to 97.

The rails under the leadership of Reading continued their advance. Reading rose 1/2 to 130, and the market was up 1/2 to 134. Chandler Motors was finally 140 1/2; Southern Pacific, 100; International, 80; Mexican Petroleum, 102 1/2; and others, 32 to 35.

Government bonds unchanged; railway and other bonds steady.

Total sales of stocks for the week were 7,720,800 shares; bonds, \$70,235,000.
