



**IMPERATOR ENDS  
VOYAGE ON SIDE**  
Giant Liner, Cabins Flooded,  
Barely Makes British Port.

LONDON, March 19.—The former German, later American, now British liner Imperator, has just completed the most sensational journey of its career. For three days the giant vessel was virtually helpless with a list of 45 degrees. First-class staterooms were flooded. Some members of the crew were killed.

The Imperator left New York on March 8. All went well until last Sunday, when, during a concert in the first-class saloon, 600 passengers were thrown from their seats as the big ship dropped to a sharp list, which increased steadily. The passengers were thrown to the deck.

The cause of the trouble is not quite clear as yet, though it is known there was a considerable ash discharge in the hold.

Several salon passengers stated definitely they received anonymous warnings not to sail on the ship.

**Air Bombs Create

ABERDEEN, Md., March 19.—Two 112 pound bombs dropped from an airplane 8,000 feet in the air during a proving process at the Aberdeen proving grounds missed their mark and falling on a railroad track in the aviation field tore up the rails for 300 feet and created a station in the town.

Naval officers from Washington were at the grounds to see the proving. Many bombs were used, but only two went astray. Owing to the danger attending this proving it was decided that there would be no more of it.
