The bill, which is pending in congress, would place an excise tax of 1 per cent upon all persons, firms or corporations owning land valued in excess of \$10,000.



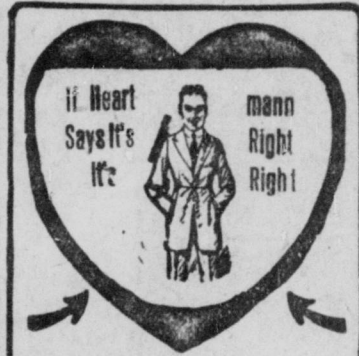

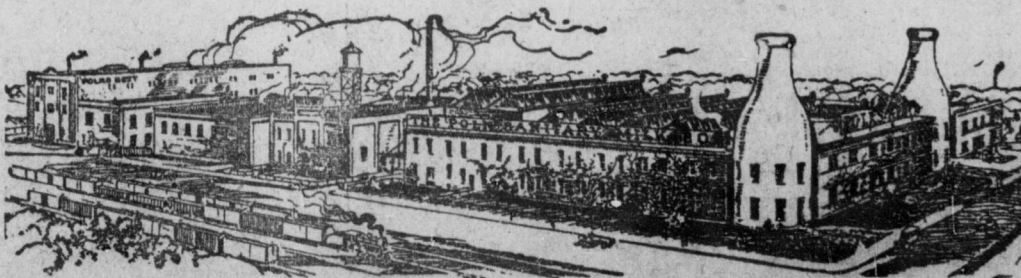
