Apartments.

AS CITY, Mo., April 1.—The lodges of the Osage Indians, once rose where buildings now stand in this city, were the forerunners of Kansas City's 1920 community apartment.

Under one roof several Indian families have lived here 200 years ago.

Now Sam Strode, lawyer, and five co-tenants try the same experiment in a mahogany and oak, mirror-doored brick apartment house.

The landlord raised the rents of the

tenants last January.

They now pay themselves \$47.50 a month.

The Indians' house.

The landlord said rents would be \$75

and probably go to \$90 later.

"Pay or get out," said the proftioneer.

Strode gathered the tenants together.

They purchased the apartment for \$26,000.

They now pay themselves \$50 a month

and will clear the principal in three years.

"It works fine," says Strode.


