

CHANGES NARROW  
IN STOCK MARKETLow-Priced Rails Develop  
Strong Tone.

NEW YORK, July 30.—The stock market displayed a steady tone today. Price changes were narrow and generally consisted of trifling gains and losses.

Low-priced rails were the feature of early trading. St. Louis-Southwestern common ran up a new high for the year. Buying of industrials during the first hour was confined to stock interests.

At the end of the first hour trading became quiet.

In the early afternoon Central Leather was driven to 33, off over 4 points from the opening. St. Louis-Southwestern issues continued to hold up, while the rest of the list was giving way.

Transactions were on a small scale to start with. The National Exchange fell nearly 7 points to 5. Railroad shares were about a point below the high levels. New shares and oil issues also were down from 1 to 2 points from the forenoon range. The close was heavy.

Government bonds were unchanged, and railway and stock bonds developed.

Total sales today were: Stocks, 353,409 shares; bonds, 9,588,000.
