

AIR TROOPSHIPS PROVE SUCCESS

British Ministry Will Not
Describe Superplane.

LONDON, Sept. 3.—The British government's experiments with "air troopships" at an airbase near London have proved a success, it was learned today. They were conducted with great secrecy under the direction of Secretary of War Winston Churchill. The "air troopships" are airplanes of unprecedented size, built by the Vickers, Ltd., and the company which constructed the Vickers Vimy, the airplane in which the late Capt. Sir John Alcock and Sir John Whitehouse crossed the Atlantic ocean.

The air ministry refused to permit any indication to be made of the description of the super-airplane with which the experiments were made, nor the number of men it carried. According to reports the air ministry planned airplanes big enough to carry light artillery as well as troops. In the past the most difficult feature which confronted the practicability of the super-airplane was the problem of getting it into the air, the weight of machine being so great as to necessitate an extraordinary long run on the ground before it gained sufficient flying speed to carry it from the ground.

A giant plane recently ran for half a mile on an airbase near London and then crashed into a fence as it did not have sufficient speed to clear the obstruction. The pilot, Capt. Dunn, was killed.

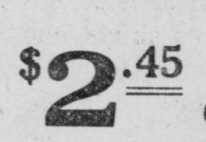

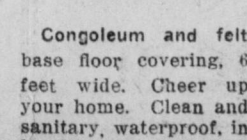
