

G. O. P. CHORUS TIRES PEOPLE

NEW YORK, Oct. 21.—Upon his return today to national headquarters from a final visit to Mid-West headquarters at Chicago, George White, chairman of the Democratic national committee, said: "The American people are tired of the chorus of Republican katydids croaking, 'he did—he didn't.'"

He issued the following statement: "The American people, being just and wise, arrive at their political decisions only when a case is completed. They discard preconceptions and propaganda in favor of the truth; that is just what they have done this year. I had no doubt of it when I left New York a few days ago for a visit to Mid-West headquarters and Ohio. I have no doubt of it now. They have made up their minds to elect Governor Cox and a Democratic Senate in order to avert the infamy of a separate peace with Germany and to order to save the league. They are weary of the chorus of Republican katydids croaking 'he did—he didn't.'"

"They will elect a foursquare President instead of a human weather-vane. Senator Harding has only stopped oscillating once and that was when he said on the league and its reservations at Des Moines: 'I don't want any clarifying reservations. I stand for rejection.'"

"Senator Johnson points out Senator Harding has put the League of Nations behind him and rejects not only the league but any modification. The people agree with Senator Johnson and they will vote for Governor Cox, who has put the league in front of him. No one has been more credulous in trying to fool the people than the Republican candidate, but Des Moines was enough for the voters as it was for Senator Johnson. When the election is over and Senator Harding is securely fixed on his front porch at Marion, I am sure Senator Johnson will publicly add a name to the list of those who have misrepresented. It is a long list. It includes the names of many Republican leaders in the country. But I want to add Senators Borah and Johnson the justice to say that all the world knows where they stand and they have not tried to fool anybody. 'The nation is for the league and will so vote, but their defeat will be the honorable defeat among the prominent Republican leaders. This campaign has become a crusade for world peace through disarmament, truth against falsehood, for straightforwardness against double dealing and for American ideals against a policy of disruption.'"

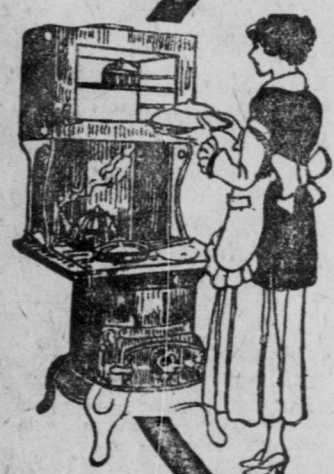

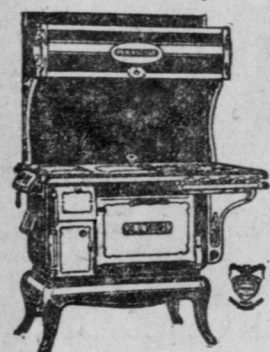

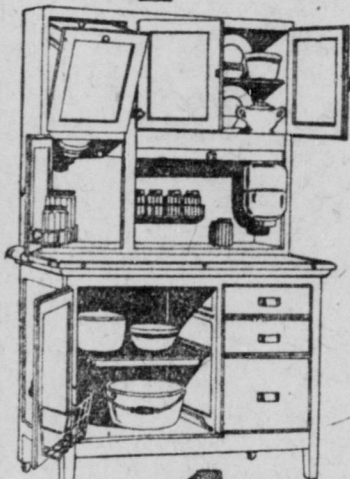
