

1,500,000 IDLE IN COUNTRIES OF OLD WORLD

Great Britain Heads List With Approximately 403,000 Unemployed.

GERMANY'S LIST LARGE

LONDON, Nov. 12.—Strikes and slackened business in Europe have left 1,500,000 workers idle.

Exact figures were not available today, but the British labor ministry put the number of unemployed at a million and a half as a conservative estimate.

In Great Britain there are 200,000 men drawing unemployment pay from the government, but there are tens of thousands more who have not benefited by the payments.

There has been no suffering. The weather has been mild. At the same time there is worry over prospects for the winter. The government has urged unions to admit unskilled labor to their ranks, especially in the building trades, which the government plans to use this winter in the construction of buildings.

Later estimates of unemployment in Great Britain were placed at 403,000.

Germany's list is estimated at 400,000. Of these many are receiving government rations. Strikes have been frequent in Germany, but much of the unemployment has been involuntary.

France has about 200,000 unemployed.

There were no statistics from Italy, Austria or central Europe, but conditions were known to be bad there. Italy has been piled upon by Bolsheviks and anarchists.

The government is now planning on giving labor a voice in the control of industry and this is expected to end much discontent.

Prices are advancing in Italy and the government has just announced new taxes with a rise in the price of bread and other staples.

The Scandinavian countries have less unemployment than any other part of Europe. The average there was believed only 2 per cent of the labor population.

Woman Struck Down by Man in Street

Mystery surrounds the attack made on Miss Frances Rembusch, 1011 South Alabama street, a stenographer employed by the Central Union Telephone Company, who was knocked down by a man while she was walking opposite 600 South Meridian street.

The man struck Miss Rembusch with some heavy implement, puncturing her wound, and ran west on Meridian street, pursued by Cland M. Scotti of the Madison Flats, who witnessed the attack.

The man made no attempt to rob Miss Rembusch and after knocking her down did not touch her, but ran away. Miss Rembusch for a time refused to tell the police her name. Scotti gave the officers an excellent description of the woman's assailant.

SHARPSVILLE STORE ROBBED.

broke into the store of S. J. Horton at Sharpsville last night and carried away \$300 worth of cigars, tobacco and other merchandise. They entered the place by cutting the plate glass in the front door.

FRANCE QUILTS IF GERMANY ENTERS

Delegate Instructed to Withdraw From Geneva Meeting.

PARIS, Nov. 12.—The French foreign office has instructed the French delegate to withdraw from the League of Nations meeting at Geneva. Immediate steps are taken to the admission of Germany into the league, it was revealed today by "Perlinax," the political editor of the Echo de Paris. According to Perlinax, Great Britain has agreed not to support Germany's request for admission to the league.

The opinion is held that if Austria

is admitted it probably would widen the breach between that country and Germany, perhaps defeating the proposal for a merger of the two nations. It is believed a special commission will be appointed by the League of Nations to examine the request of Germany and Austria for admission and will report at a future meeting.

The meeting will open Monday.
