

**DE PAUW HOUSING FACILITIES SHORT**

President's Report Shows Need Accommodations.

GREENCASTLE, Ind., Nov. 12.—De Pauw University officials may have to "smelt" the number of students who enter the institution next year because of a shortage of housing accommodations here, according to reports of the president and other officers of the school for the year 1919-1920.

The report of President George H. Grose says:  
"The housing condition of our students presents one of the gravest problems at the present time. Of the women students 20 live in their own homes, 125 in sorority houses, 107 in lodging houses and 231 in the two halls of residence."

"Men's Hall, with a capacity of sixty, ten fraternity houses and private houses in town afford accommodations for the men students. The fraternity and sorority houses are overcrowded and in some instances not well suited for their purpose."

"With the sorority and fraternity houses already filled, with every room in the women's halls engaged and a waiting list of seventy-five, and with assured accommodations for only sixty women in private homes, with a reliable prospect of a larger number of men in attendance than ever before, through the provisions of the Rector Scholarship Foundation, I see no means at present for caring next fall for the young people who are knocking at our doors for admission."

De Pauw University now has fifteen buildings devoted to college use. This plant, including apparatus and equipment, is conservatively appraised at \$1,000,000. The physical plant is now in better condition for work than at any time in the last eight years.

**SAYS COAL EXPORT IS NOT H. C. CAUSE**

Commission Reports Seaports Were Affected Most.

NEW YORK, Nov. 12.—Coal exports so far this year amount to only 8.5 per cent of the country's total production, the Interstate Commerce Commission said in a statement today.

While this is larger than exports for the years from 1914 to 1919, when they ranged from 3.38 per cent and 6.19 per cent of the production, it was a minor factor in bringing about "unjustified" prices over the country as a whole, but did cause exorbitant prices at New York, Philadelphia, Baltimore, Hampton Roads and Charleston, S. C., the commission said. For the first nine months of the year the export and bunker demands through these ports was more than one-half the coal shipped to these ports.

"The foreign demand intensified the abnormal domestic demand," said the statement, "and the several factors together afforded an opportunity for the exacting of prices not justified by the cost of production. For the country as a whole the foreign demand was a minor factor but in that part of the Eastern coast section which was dependent on shipments on the water, the foreign demand was a very important factor."

This statement was asked in a Senate resolution passed June 4, 1920.

**It's the Men Who Delay Loading on P. A. Y. E. Trolleys**

Is the old tale about the woman who got on a street car, opened her purse, took out a quarter, closed her purse, paid her fare, opened her pocketbook and put the change back in, meanwhile holding up a line of people who wanted to get on, typical of Indianapolis women? It is not.

It's the men, not the women, who cause the delays in loading pay-as-you-enter street cars.

Fifty-four persons got on an East Washington street car. Twenty-four were men and thirty women. Of the twenty-four men eighteen got on with their fares in their hands while six

waited until they unbuttoned their overalls and took off their gloves to dig down in their jeans. But twenty-eight of the women had their fares ready and only two had to hunt. After they got seated nine out of thirteen women on the "tete-a-tete" seats in the rear of the car sat with hands and feet crossed. Twenty-six men and twenty-nine women got on another car. Three of the men did not have their fares ready while all but one of the women were prepared.

The men who got on an Illinois car were the worst offenders of all. Out of twenty-nine, seven had to search before paying. The twenty-three women who got on were 100 per cent prepared.


