Department Heads and Employees Becoming Independent in Views.

MAYOR'S DREAMS FADE?

Signs of disintegration of the administration of Mayor Charles W. Jewett are becoming so evident at the hall that members of the official family even are beginning to wonder whether the chief executive has given up all political ambitions for the future. With department heads and various employees, important and unimportant, drifting one by one from under the discipline of the chief executive, so that they are becoming increasingly independent in their views and official actions, those who still adhere closely to the mayor question whether the government organization can be welded together again in time to accomplish the tremendous program which must be completed next year if the city is to retain its position as a great metropolis. The mayor is earnestly endeavoring to hold the refractory forces in line, but he is somewhat exasperated at the continued lack of leadership on the part of the department heads. He is talking for publication that "don't see how he ever expects to accomplish anything if he doesn't get back on the job."

LET'S GET BUSY

The mayor, however, stated a few days after the election that "we must get busy now and get something done," and this is being repeated daily. The mayor is planning to have the city administration complete the track extension project, build the municipal yards and the nurses' home, complete the street resurfacing program, and complete the city hall extension. To make clear the extent of the lack of cooperation in the city hall, it is necessary to picture the excellent condition of every department excepting the city council, which the mayor held during the first year of his term. It was the custom in those early days to hold meetings of all the department heads and sometimes of their assistants in the mayor's chambers. These meetings were called "cabinet sessions." Policies of every department were discussed at these sessions, and plans for the future mapped out, sometimes in minute detail. The mayor frequently attended meetings of the board of works and board of safety and sometimes of other boards. Always he had his hand on the helm and things went as he and his intimate counselors decreed, excepting when they bumped into the city council. The mayor never had the cooperation of the majority of the council. Today he has lost even the good wishes of part of the minority which used to fight to the last ditch for him.

INTO POWER

Through the first and most of the second years of the administration the mayor, or the forces which work through and behind the mayor, really ruled. It was in the middle of the second year, 1919, that the executive's hold began to wobble. George Y. Coffey, chief of police, was removed practically by the board of public safety over the mayor's strenuous objections, although the public was told he had been removed. The law had been broken. The mayor could not even keep his own chief of police in office against the wishes of A. L. Tazewell, chief of the board of safety, and others began to gather round to oppose the executive. The rush was general with the formation of the "anti movement," which was the real movement of the Republican party the fight of its life to retain control of the Marion County organization early this year before the primary election.

About this time Mayor Jewett became more interested in the breeding of top-notch hogs at his Arlington Place farm northwest of the city, and thereupon Samuel Ashby, corporation counsel, became the real mayor of Indianapolis. The mayor's hog-raising interests and occasional interest in the presidential campaign to the extent of "sounding the hunting season" for the other States, kept him far afield, so that day after day he was either not at his office in the City Hall at all, or was there for only a few minutes.

CITIZENS' FLOOD

Persons on private, civic and political business came to the executive chambers, were told the mayor might be reached while waiting long and unsuccessfully and went away disgusted. Those who had business which needed immediate attention and knew something of the city hall went to the corporation counsel and sometimes got something done, depending on how far that busy official was covered up by his double duties.

Meanwhile the mayor continued losing the slender hold he had on the city council. EVEN FURNISS IS COOLING

Even Dr. Furniss is not such an ardent supporter of the mayor's designs as might be expected from their frequent conferences. It has been announced both by Mr. Jewett and Corporation Counsel Ashby that the administration opposes the granting of the right to charge 2 cents for transfers to the Indianapolis Street Railway Company. In the early days of the Jewett tenure this would have been the law for everybody in the City Hall, but Dr. Furniss apparently is unimpressed. A survey of the opinion of city officials on the 2-cent transfer charge was being made and Dr. Furniss was asked what he thought of the matter.

"Well, I don't like to express an opinion without giving the matter some thought. I will have to give that matter consideration," he replied. Mr. Ashby and the mayor do not even have the president of the most important board in their stand on the Indianapolis street railway company's petition for relief. George W. Lemaux, president of the board of public works, has stated for publication on several occasions that he believed "the company should have at least 1 cent a transfer increase in fare, asserting that the company must have more money in order to carry out a program of improvements and extensions which the board has in mind for its next year."

CLASH ON OVER GAS CASE

It is no secret also that in the negotiations which resulted in the agreement between the board of works and the Citizens Gas Company, consummated Monday, by which the gas company binds itself to make \$2,750,000 worth of plant extensions and improvements (if it can sell its stock) and to ration gas during periods of shortage so as to give cooks the preference, Mr. Lemaux frequently clashed with Mr. Ashby. In fact, Mr. Lemaux was more inclined to side with Mr. Schmidt and Mr. Wilson of the council than with Mr. Ashby. The difficulties were ironed out, but not before Mr. Lemaux had his say.

The same is true of Mr. Ashby who was the sole real representative of the administration mind in the negotiations with the gas company, and in the opposition to the street railway's new plan for financial relief. It is taken by city hall folk as further evidence that Mr. Ashby is the power to see. Mr. Jewett has turned almost everything over to Mr. Ashby, they believe, while he has been and about the country for new blood for his pedigreed doves.

MAYOR NOT AT CONFERENCE

Mayor Jewett never attended any of the gas conferences to which reporters were admitted. He has never issued a single statement of his views on the amendments to the gas franchise. His only interest in the street railway situation came not along ago when, in response to a question put by newspapermen, he said his views are reflected correctly by Mr. Ashby.

One of the most independent of department heads is Dwight S. Ritter, city purchasing agent, who is picked for the job out of a big business institution with the public declaration by the mayor that he was being chosen because of his ability as a purchasing agent. He is the important official in the administration, especially because he knows his job.

Mr. Ritter has been found blocking moves of the administration which he did not subscribe to on several occasions. Now Mr. Ritter has a proposal of his own and the administration is said to be opposing it. By the word administration, Corporation Counsel Ashby is meant in this instance.

HAS NEW SYSTEM FOR BUYING

The purchasing agent desires a new system of public purchase, which he says will save the city thousands on thousands of dollars. To put this system by which the purchasing agent would be empowered to buy articles needed by city departments in large quantities and pay for them direct out of funds under his control, into effect will require new legislation and the construction of a storehouse for the surplus stocks. The various departments would draw their supplies as needed from this warehouse.

TRAIN SAVED FROM BANDITS

Brakeman, With Shotgun, Foils Robber Gang Near Denver.

DENVER, Nov. 17.—Police and railroad detectives early today were scouring the countryside east of this city in search of train bandits who were foiled in an attempt to hold up Rock Island passenger train No. 6, east-bound for Kansas City and Chicago, last night.

The Rock Island train, which was running over Union Pacific trackage, was flagged at Sandow, a small station six miles east of Denver. A brakeman with a shotgun fired upon the bandits as they started to board the mail car as the train came to a halt. Other members of the train crew joined the brakeman and a score of shots were exchanged with the robbers who fled in a high-powered automobile.

Two Pullman cars of Union Pacific train No. 114, which left Denver for Kansas City thirty minutes after the Rock Island train over the same route, were derailed at the scene of the attempted hold-up shortly after the Rock Island train had proceeded on its way. Many passengers were shaken up, but none was seriously hurt. It is believed the derailed was the result of a thrown switch in a second attempt at train robbery.

Denver police reported early today that six men were in the bandit gang, but all trace of them had been lost.

STATE CRISIS IN COAL SHORTAGE UP BY WEATHER

There will be no shortage in the near future. Grades for commercial use are plentiful. The only trouble is delay in receiving shipments.

GREENSBURG

GREENSBURG, Ind., Nov. 17.—The coal shortage is serious here, but it is reported a supply is on the way. Pending the arrival of this only one dealer has coal, and because he can not deliver it fast enough, consumers are delivering it themselves. Many have been hauling coal from nearby towns and villages. Everything possible is being done to prevent suffering from lack of fuel.

HARTFORD CITY

HARTFORD CITY, Ind., Nov. 17.—Hartford City dealers declared today that the coal situation is the best it has been in weeks. The arrival of six railroads on Tuesday relieved immediate need and large supplies are reported en route. No manufacturing plants are threatened with immediate shortage, although some have a large supply of coal. The natural gas shortage here makes the demand for fuel greater.

VALPARAISO

VALPARAISO, Ind., Nov. 17.—Three of the four coal yards in this city say they have coal for their customers at from \$2.50 to \$3.25 a ton. One of the largest dealers is out of coal and two of them are short. No Indiana coal is being shipped to Valparaiso because of the price restrictions set by the State. Nobody has hard coal nor Pocahontas and not much Pocahontas is expected to be brought to Valparaiso. The gas works and the water company are supplied with fuel.

MARIION, Ind., Nov. 17.—A majority of Marion coal dealers are receiving shipments from the mines in Indiana, Illinois and the eastern States. It is believed the present supply will be sufficient to meet ordinary domestic demands. The plant of the local lighting and heating company and public institutions are well supplied with coal.

GREENCASTLE, Ind., Nov. 17.—Unless the exhausted fuel supply of this city is replenished within a short time many citizens will be suffering from the cold. Calls for coal which have been sent out from here during the last few days were renewed with vigor when the mercury began to drop.
