

**TRY PERSUASION  
ON D'ANNUNZIO**  
Committee to Ask Poet to Re-nounce War.

MILAN, Dec. 3.—A parliamentary committee has gone from Rome to Flume to attempt to persuade Gabriele D'Annunzio to renounce his declaration of war against Italy. This committee was empowered to enter into "peace negotiations" with D'Annunzio in an effort to induce him to cease resistance against the government of Italy, which is doing Flume.

Warlike preparations have continued at Flume for forty-eight hours. D'Annunzio's declaration of war against Italy, unless the Italian government backed down, was to be effective today.

According to press advices from Rome an enormous majority of the people demand "an honorable surrender."

These are ex-Senator George W. Sutherland of Utah and ex-Senator John W. Weeks of Massachusetts. Only the posts to which they will be appointed remain to be decided, according to Harding's friends here.

Senator James E. Watson of Indiana went to Philadelphia to confer with Senator Penrose, ostensibly over financial legislation.

Daugherty will leave Washington tonight for Norfolk, where he will meet Senator Harding on his arrival from Panama. Edward B. McLean and Senator Davis Elkins of West Virginia will also go to the port to welcome the Harding party.

est towns in Indiana—not a drop of evidence anywhere. Two of the investigators already have returned to Indianapolis.

But the black-headlined press agent of the arrival of the Federal men had the effect of waking up some of the local authorities. To be specific, it woke up the county authorities, for the city authorities are still soundly slumbering and are apparently the only ones who do

not know the town is in the throes of a sensation.

Judge William A. Bond of the Wayne County Circuit Court ordered an immediate investigation by the grand jury to determine whether all the reports about law violations were true. The grand jury still is in session and has returned numerous findings and returned indictments. Then there were a number of officials—meaning city officials—would be indicted.
