

CONGRESS MAY ACT IN RECENT CABLE TROUBLE

Legislation Sought to Cover Cases Similar to Miami Beach Affair.

SENATE HEARING HELD

WASHINGTON, Dec. 17.—Legislation likely to prove of great economic and political importance is in prospect as a consequence of the hearings before the Senate committee on the cable situation. The legislation would be confined to regulation of cables entering the United States, but may have an effect on international, political and business relations.

The committee sat in the conference between the Western Union and the Government over the Western Union's application for a permit to land a cable to Miami Beach, Fla., connecting with a British cable to Brazil at Bahia. The Western Union disputes the president's power to control cable landings under license or permits and claims the right to an undersea cable passed in 1866.

The Government insists upon its right to lay down conditions precedent to the landing of the cable.

Senator Kellogg, chairman of the committee, indicated legislation would be formulated along these lines:

1. Definition of the Government's power to regulate cable companies to before granting such permits.

2. Authorization of some governmental agency to fix conditions.

3. Authorization of naval radio stations to transmit press and commercial messages as well as Government business and fixing a low rate for press.

"The best thing," said Kellogg, "would be to have an international agreement for uniform cable landing licenses and rules, so that all countries would accord similar treatment to foreign cable companies."

Kellogg is of the opinion that the United States should refuse to let foreign cables land here unless foreign governments grant the same chance to connect with land communication lines abroad as the foreign companies enjoy here. This is not done now.

CENSORSHIP NOT IMPOSED

LONDON, Dec. 17.—The Admiralty today issued a formal denial that a censorship has been imposed upon cables to the United States. "The report is absolutely untrue," said the statement.

(President Newcomb Carleton of the Western Union Cable Co. announced in Washington on Thursday that all cables from Great Britain to the United States were being passed upon by the intelligence department of the Admiralty.)



HOOSIER PAYS TOLL IN WRECK

GRAND RAPIDS, Mich., Dec. 17.—Officials of the Pennsylvania Railroad report today that one death resulted from the wreck of the company's Cincinnati flyer, which was derailed at Ross Station, thirteen miles south of here, last night at 9:25. The flyer hit a split switch, the locomotive toppled into the ditch, carrying three coaches with it. W. F. Temple, 38, fireman, of Ft. Wayne, was crushed and scalped to death when pinned under the locomotive. Engineer R. J. Jones, 35, also of Ft. Wayne, who did not have time to jump now.

when the red light of the switch flashed into view, stuck to his post, reversed the brakes and escaped with slight injuries. His life was saved when he was protected by a pocket formed by the crumpling timbers of the locomotive cab.

Passengers of the train, which consisted of seven coaches, including two for Cincinnati and one for Indianapolis, were shaken up but only a few were hurt, none seriously.
