

NAME CHANGED TO TRAFFIC CLUB

F. A. Butler Elected Head of Transportation Body.

The Transportation Club of Indianapolis, at a meeting at the Hotel Severin last night voted to change the name of the organization to the Indianapolis Traffic Club.

The following officers were elected: President, F. A. Butler; first vice president, B. W. Fredenburg; second vice president, O. K. Jeffries; third vice president, W. S. Parkhurst; secretary-treasurer, G. N. Baker; directors, W. H. Coltharp, A. S. Winter, I. L. Frye, E. M. Elliott and F. R. Humston.

It was decided that membership in the club should be divided into two classes, one, to be known as the railroad group, composed of members directly or indirectly engaged in transportation work, and the other, to be known as the shippers' group, to be composed of business men.

Candidates for office in the club will be selected in alternate years from these groups. Dues in the organization were increased to \$10 a year for active members and \$5 a year for nonresident members.

Robbers Escape With Approximately \$2,500.

ANDERSON, Ind., Dec. 17.—Robbers entered the Fair department store here Thursday evening while crowds of people were passing along the street, broke open the safe and escaped with approximately \$2,500 in cash and checks. The robbery was committed between 6 and 7 o'clock and its similarity to one that was committed in Indianapolis on Wednesday night causes the police to believe that the same men pulled off the affair here. D. C. Ross discovered the robbery when he visited the office and found the safe open and documents scattered about the floor. The robbers had entered by breaking a glass in a door at the basement entrance. The combination on the safe was broken off and the bolts lifted. Police believe the robbery was done by professionals, that one man was stationed as a watcher and that the yegmen made their escape in an automobile. The store is owned by A. Strauss, & Co.
