

REPORT OF TRUST COMPANIES MADE

Indiana Institutions Stand Eleventh in Nation.

The combined assets of Indiana trust companies stand eleventh among the states of the Union, according to statistics compiled by the United States Mortgage and Trust Company of New York for publication in "Trust Companies of the United States," copies of which have just been received by local bankers. The figures show that Indiana had 156 trust companies reporting as of June 30, 1920, with combined assets of \$20,642,625.14. New York was next among the States, with combined assets of \$30,992,219.10, and Pennsylvania was second with \$15,894,685.74. New York had but ninety-nine trust companies reporting, while Pennsylvania had 324 companies reporting, the largest number of any State.

Deposits in the ten Indianapolis trust companies are shown as follows: Atenta Trust and Savings, \$2,104,401; Bankers Trust, \$1,237,223.45; First National Trust, \$75,974.16; First Trust, \$1,741,765.85; Fidelity Trust, \$1,894,831.78; Fletcher Savings and Trust, \$14,104,840.82; Indiana Trust, \$9,022,403.32; Security Trust, \$2,263,551.74; State Savings and Trust, \$2,580,686.04; Union Trust, \$6,056,736.28; and Washington Bank and Trust, \$1,453,43.

The total assets of the trust companies of the Nation, according to the New York compiler, were given as \$12,451,877,383.58, a substantial gain from 1919 when the total was \$11,550,445,067.53.

THREE MEN FACE ARSON CHARGES

Bedford Trio Held for Burning Freetown Store.

BEDFORD, Ind., Dec. 23.—William Beck, Dan and Dewey Brevers are under arrest here on a charge of setting fire to the John L. Sprague general store at Freetown after burglarizing the place Monday night, and were taken to Brownstown, where they will be given a preliminary hearing on the charge of arson today. Damage from the fire is said to be approximately more than \$30,000.

Howard Greer of Bedford, who was also placed under arrest, is reported to have told the authorities that the three men charged with arson borrowed his motor truck Monday night, saying they wanted to go to the country. When the truck was found in a wrecked condition three miles east of Freetown with several pairs of shoes near, the men were arrested. Later, 180 pairs of shoes were found hidden under a bridge.

Greer denied that he had any part in the robbery and said he loaned his truck to the men in good faith.


Miss Robinson has on deposit here is money paid by them to Watson. The bank was enjoined from paying any part of the \$22,000 until pending litigation is completed.

CANNED CORNED BEEF WITH CREAMED CABBAGE

1 1/2 cups Water. Dept. canned corned beef

1 head of cabbage, about one pound

1 teaspoon salt

Pepper and paprika

Cut the cabbage into small pieces and cover with cold water for thirty minutes; drain and cover with boiling water and boil thirty to thirty-five minutes in uncovered vessel. Drain and add to the meat and sauce, seasoned to taste. Mix well and boil three minutes.

While the cabbage is cooking the canned corned beef is heated in the can.

The canned corned beef is put in center of platter and the creamed cabbage around the edge. Sprinkle all with paprika and garnish with parsley.
