## SOUTH AFRICA AT FEVER HEAT ON SECESSION

Imperialists Claim Support of Labor Against Division From Empire.

'CLASS WAR' IS ISSUE

LONDON, Feb. 7.—The political campaign in the union of South Africa, with African secession from the British empire as the leading issue, has reached fever heat and the whole country is in a whirlwind of excitement, said advices from Capetown, Pretoria and Durban today. The balloting will take place tomorrow.

Followers of General Smuts, leader of the Imperialists, and secessionists, labor will support the Imperialists on some issues, notably the continuation of South Africa as part of the British empire, but will oppose other planks of the Imperialists' platform.

Secession from the British empire is the chief plank of the Nationalists, led by General Herzog, who desire South Africa converted into an independent republic.

Local leaders declare that whether South Africa remains in the British empire or not they will make "class war" a live issue in the country.

NEW YORK, Feb. 7.—Dazed as though from drugs, a young woman was saved by the police early today just as she was about to jump into East River at Ninth Street.

She was stylishly dressed and later was identified at the city hospital as Lillian J. Wilhelm of Travis, Mich., a music student.

The police said they found a silver table knife protruding from the girl's sleeve.
