REPORT LANDIS  
MAY QUIT BENCH

Friends Say Resignation May  
Be Outcome.

CHICAGO, March 3.—Judge Kenesaw  
Mountain Landis maintained strict silence  
today regarding the report of the Ju-  
diciary Committee of the House of Rep-  
resentatives at Washington, which recom-  
mended a thorough hearing of impeach-  
ment charges against him by the next  
Congress.

Among Judges, he is close to the  
judges, however, there were persistent re-  
ports that the Federal jury would re-  
sign if Congress indicates its intention of  
 instituting formal impeachment proceed-  
ings.

Speaking before the Missouri Bar As-  
sociation a few weeks ago, Judge Landis  
said:

"There is a method by which a Federal  
judge may be removed from office if he is  
unsatisfactory and that is by impeach-  
ment. But they will never impeach me.  
The House of Congress is not the  
body which is responsible for impeach-  
ment. It is the Federal jury which is responsible  
for my removal.

Landis declared his position as outlined  
therein has not changed.
