

STATE BEGINS FIGHT FOR PURE WATER SUPPLY

Department of Conservation
Outlines Plans to Prevent
Stream Pollution.

"There are wastes that are not capable of conversion into marketable products, but which, nevertheless, are dangerous to the stream," says a bulletin on stream pollution issued by the State department of conservation, which has started a campaign to save the water resources of the State, many streams and small lakes of which are used as cess pools for dumping municipal wastes and industrial refuse. "The best method pursued is treatment to remove the dangerous element so that it may be sent into the stream harmless. Here the chief problem is economy of method so that it does not work a hardship upon the manufacturer," the bulletin adds.

"Our streams should be and are a source of constant food supply and great health resorts. "It is true that fish from Indiana waters are not on the market, nor are they permitted to be, yet thousands of pounds are caught annually and used on our tables. More should be used.

"The State spends thousands of dollars each year to propagate fish to stock our streams and lakes. When pollution continues, it is much the same as trying to fill a funnel, to plant young fish at the most delicate age, into polluted streams and expect them to thrive and multiply. "Waste dumped into streams does not only kill by direct poisoning. It may possess a component which removes the oxygen from the water, rendering it uninhabitable to aquatic life. It may destroy the plankton, the millions of minute bugs and worms and floating plants which constitute the food of fishes. It may be simply dirt which settles to the bottom and covers the clean sand and gravel in which are fashioned the nests where fish eggs are deposited and hatched. If a clean bottom is not available fishes will migrate to other grounds in the spawning season.

"Dead fish are not the only indication that a stream is polluted sufficiently to injure or destroy fish. In fact, it is only in the very worst cases this condition is true.

"When dead fish are seen we readily know the situation is acute. A biological analysis of the waters is the final and accurate test of pollution effect. Dead fish may or may not be present, the water may not kill the fish, but if it is shown in the analysis that the water organism which compose the fishes' food are absent, if fifth blankets the breeding grounds, then we know without question of contradiction that such pollution is injurious to fish and in need of conversion and elimination.

"Many of our streams today are biologically deserts due to pollution which has literally wiped out the water life which constitutes fish food. Fish may appear in such water and live, but they will not remain there, neither do they multiply. In the end they either migrate or succumb for lack of sustenance."

FIGHTING MAYOR AFTER RENT HOGS

Higher Tax Assessment Is
Scheme in Utica.

UTICA, N. Y., March 11.—James K. O'Connor, "fighting mayor" of Utica, has launched a drive against profiteering landlords.

"We'll give the lying, thieving, profiteering landlords a dose of their own medicine," O'Connor said. The city of Utica plans to get at the landlords through their wallets. If mayors of other cities throughout the United States would start similar drives, O'Connor believes the profiteering landlord would become practically extinct.

The mayor explained his plan as follows: "In case a landlord raises a tenant's rent exorbitantly, say 50 per cent, the tax assessor will compute the value of the property on a basis of ten years' rental at the increased figure.

"If the tenants and newspapers will cooperate with me, I'll smash this rent-raising ring in short order."
