

BIRDS' FRIEND TO SPEAK HERE

Will Tell Indianapolis Folk
How to Aid Song
Bird.

How to attract song birds around the home will be discussed before the bird loving public of Indianapolis by Joseph H. Dodson, Kankakee, Ill., president of the American Bird Society. He will speak at Caleb Mills Hall Tuesday. Mr. Dodson's lectures will be free, being given under the auspices of the board of school commissioners and board of public park commissioners.

Tuesday afternoon Mr. Dodson will speak to the children of the upper grades of the public schools. His address in the evening will be to the public. Both lectures will be illustrated.

Mr. Dodson is authority for the state-

ment that a crop loss of \$1,200,000 a year from noxious insects could be prevented by increasing the number of song birds.

Birds to thrive in this section of the country, he says, must be furnished with some artificial means of shelter, the building of great cities and the denuding of the forests having deprived them of their natural nesting sites.

If it's desired to attract birds to the home food should be kept in feeding stations in the fall, winter and spring. These stations should be put out in cold weather and fresh, cool water in the summer. The food and water should always be placed in the same places, so the birds will become accustomed to seeking them there.

It is possible, Mr. Dodson says, to keep Red Birds, Chickadees, Nuthatches, Down and Hairy Woodpeckers, Brown Creepers and many other varieties of feathered beauties from migrating south in the winter by providing proper food, water and shelter.

Many other interesting things about birds will be told by Mr. Dodson.
