GIVES GLIMPSE
BEHIND SCENES
OF BIG ROADSIllinois Central Explains Vast
Work in Maintenance of
Modern Railway.

ARMY IS EMPLOYED

A glimpse "behind the scenes" in railway management and operation is afforded in a letter received by local officials of the Illinois Central Railway, and made public today. The letter gives an idea of the work required in the maintenance of a locomotive, or the organization that is necessary in keeping the railway in proper condition, and in safeguarding the public which uses the utility.

Few persons, according to the letter, are aware of the monster organization that is behind the operation of a railway. Few others ever examine a modern locomotive, a passenger coach, a refrigerator or ordinary freight car. An idea of the work required in the construction of a locomotive, or of the officials behind the organization is given in the letter.

MODERN LOCOMOTIVE
HAS 4,000 PARTS.

Modern locomotives, it states, is composed of more than 4,000 parts, not including rivets and bolts, all of which must be inspected daily and kept in perfect condition, some requiring the attention of highly-specialized experts. A modern all-steel passenger coach, exclusive of bolts, rivets, etc., has more than 2,000 parts. The wheels, trucks, air-brakes and draw gear require constant attention. The dynamo, which generates electricity for lighting the coach when the train is running, and storing the batteries to power lighting when the train is standing, must be carefully handled.
