

4TH MEMBER OF FAMILY IN AUTO ACCIDENT DIES

Baby Succumbs to Hurts—Parents and Brother Killed Outright.

GREENSBURG, Ind., July 29.—After lying unconscious through the night, George Anderson, 40, the father, a prominent Rush county farmer, his wife, Mary Anderson, 30, and an infant son, Rush Elston Anderson, were killed outright.

The accident occurred at McGehee station, five miles from Greensburg, on the family's auto route home from an all-day Sunday school picnic at Hillsdale Park east of here. Mr. Anderson, who was driving, had stopped the machine near the tracks during a rainstorm. Later, when he started to drive across the Big Four right of way, his view of the tracks was obstructed by a string of empty freight cars on a siding and he drove directly in the path of an on-coming train.

The locomotive struck the Anderson machine squarely, completely wrecking it.

Mr. Anderson's body was carried a distance of 200 feet, killing him instantly.

The mother and children were buried

against a pole, the infant being killed instantly and Mrs. Anderson succumbed within a short time.

The force of the impact when the engine struck the automobile caused the gasoline tank to explode and portions of the car were enveloped in flames, being fuelled to fire because of being wet from rain.

Mr. and Mrs. Anderson were among the best-known people of Rush County and were well-to-do. He was formerly trustee of Richland Township, Rush County.

CROWN GENERAL TO BE ARRESTED

Commander of British Forces Ordered to Produce Irishmen Sentenced to Death.

DUBLIN, July 29.—A sentence was passed here today when the president of the Supreme Court issued a writ against Gen. Sir Nevil MacReady, commander-in-chief of the crown forces; General Cameron and General Strickland, in an action which may involve their arrest.

The action developed from an order for a writ of habeas corpus issued recently and calling for the production of the Irishmen sentenced to death by sentence to death by a British court martial. The men were not produced. The judge who issued the writ described the action of the military authorities as an attempt to resist the courts by force of arms.

SINN FEIN REJECT TERMS; OFFER NEW

DUBLIN, July 29.—Sinn Fein today began drafting a selection of the principal terms in the British peace proposals, principally regarding the degree of self-government and the relations to be maintained between Ulster and the southern provinces.

The republicans will not be sent to London before the middle of next week. It is being drafted from a trading viewpoint. That is, the principal terms in their present nebulous state are turned down with the idea that the counter proposals will lead to further parleys. If the government's offer is accepted, the republicans will not be sent to London, but will remain in Dublin for more conversations. This iteration, it can be stated authoritatively, would be accepted. If the government's proposition is a flat "take it or leave it" offer, the peace negotiations seem doomed.

SHERMAN DRIVE ORDER ENTERED

"Link" Improvement Authorized by Works Board.

That section of Sherman drive from Twenty-First street to Thirtieth street, which now is unpaved, will be permanently improved following approval of a resolution today by the board of public works for the permanent improvement of the street, under the "connecting link" law passed in the last session of the Legislature. Under this law, property owners along that section will pay on 50 per cent of their assessed valuation, and the city and county will divide equally, the remainder of the cost.

Sherman Drive now is paved from Troy street to Twenty-First street, and from Thirtieth to Thirtieth street.

The board ordered plans prepared as follows: Vacation of the second alley north of New York street from Cleveland street to the first alley east; sidewalks in Forty-fifth street, from Winthrop to Gulford avenues; sidewalks and curbs in Stuart street from the first alley north of Twenty-Sixth street to Twenty-Eighth street; the opening of the first alley north of Michigan street from Believile place to the first alley east.

The board ordered the city street commission to rebuild the curbs and sewer inlets at Thirty-Fourth and Illinois streets, where a change in the street car trucks has made this work possible.

By refusal to sign a resolution for the permanent improvement of Langsland avenue from Northwestern avenue to 20 feet west of the first alley west, the board officially killed this resolution. It was placed on the records as adopted Wednesday.

JUNIOR BUSSES MAKE INROADS

Turning his attention to the loss of business suffered by the street car company through jitney bus operation, Mr. McGowan said that the jitney competition is strongest on the West Washington, West Indianapolis, South Meridian, English avenue and West Michigan street lines. The company, he said, has a majority of jitney bus business for those lines.

Also there will be dancing and music.

Effort to Develop Facts About Pellagra

WASHINGTON, July 29.—The last thing in the administration's mind is to exaggerate the seriousness of the pellagra situation in the South, President Harding today stated in a letter to Representative Byrnes, South Carolina.

"The effort is merely to develop the facts so that a proper course may be determined in view of them," the President wrote.

Byrnes has introduced a resolution calling upon the President to state upon what facts he urged the United States Public Health Service and the Red Cross to meet the alleged situation in southern States.
