TERRE HAUTE, Ind., Sept. 9.—Negro bandits continue their operations in and around Terre Haute. Fred Halsapple, local taxi driver, was held up Thursday and robbed of \$75 by negro bandits. Jacob Hess, conductor on the Chicago, Milwaukee & St. Paul Railroad, while returning home early Thursday morning was attacked. Hess opened fire. Cries and moans of the men were said to have been heard, indicating that one of the shots took effect. No blood could be found. No arrests have been made.

FRANKLIN, Ind., Sept. 9.—Two girls who escaped from the Indiana Industrial School for Girls at Clermont Saturday night were found dressed in men's clothing two miles south of here late Thursday, by L. M. Bass, a farmer, who took them in custody and brought them to the Johnson County jail, where they are being held for the arrival of the school officials.

The girls gave their names as Addie Collett, 19, of Evansville, and Lulu Phelps 19, of Evansville. Neither of the girls had money and said they begged food on the way and slept by the roadside at night. Both admitted former attempts to escape from the home.

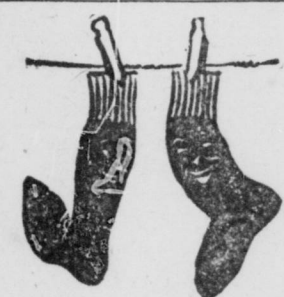
