

CHINA TO FIGHT OFF CONTROL BY NIPPON FORCES

Expects America to Aid at
Disarmament and Far
East Parley.

WASHINGTON, Oct. 14.—China pro-
poses to purge her soil of foreign con-
trol. European domination of the Far East
must end in so far as it interferes with
the economic control of China by Japan.
To this end China is preparing to

exert every ounce of diplomacy and to
throw into the balance every gram of
sympathy and influence she may be able
to secure from the United States.
The armament and Far East conference
is to be made the battle ground
for China's fight for freedom from the
invidious hand of the foreigner.

This dream of a new China, realization
of which China hopes will place her
among the great powers of the world,
was made known by Feng Hua Huang,
secretary of the Chinese delegation to
the armament and Far East conference,
upon his arrival in Washington to ar-
range details incident to China's part
in the forthcoming conference.

WOULD PURCHASE FOREIGN HOLDINGS.

"China plays and hopes to re-secure by
direct purchase foreign rights and inter-
ests in Chinese railways and commercial
enterprises in an effort to destroy the

'spheres of influence' exerted in China
by Japan, Great Britain, France, Bel-
gium, Portugal and Italy," Huang said.
"Its purpose," he continued, "is to re-
cover to itself the economic strongholds
of the country. To do this it is neces-
sary that China remove for all time the
'spheres of influence' within her borders.
China cannot hope to win economic in-
dependence until she has shaken off the
grasp of foreign domination."

The first step in this sweeping reforma-
tion of policy is outright purchase of cer-
tain railways now in the hands of for-
eign powers and the gradual purchase
of all other railways now operated by
foreign interests, Huang explained.

"China," he said, "would allow no for-
eign interests to entail any loss in the
proposed purchases—cent for cent, China
will pay for the railways, rights of way
and other privileges held by foreign
powers."

The greater railway lines in China,

owned and operated by foreign auspices
are the South Manchurian railway, the
Chinese Eastern railway, the Yun Nan
railway and the Shantung railway.
The chief railway lines in China owned
by the Chinese government, but with a
large measure of administrative control,
reserved by the mortgage holders, are the
Pekin-Hankow Railway, the Pekin-Muk-
den lines and the Chanting Tai Yuen
Railway.

In addition to these railways, mort-
gages and railway loans, China is lit-
erally nailed to the wall by foreign
mortgages in other enterprises. Italy,
Portugal, France and Great Britain have
great commercial concessions and de-
pendency ports of entry in China.

CHILDREN UNDER 16 GO TO SCHOOL

Those Who Finish Grades Not
Exempt.

Children under 16 in Indiana must at-
tend school regardless of whether they
have completed grade school, B. J. Burris,
State superintendent of public instruc-
tion, declared today. He said that in
a number of cases parents of children
under 16 have refused to send them to

high school, regardless of the attendance
laws.

In this connection a case was brought
to compel the attendance in high school
of John R. Ummell of Harrison Town-
ship, Elkhart County. The boy with
his parents, consent, according to Mr.
Burris, refused to attend school. He was
sent to school, however, after the action
was started and the case was dropped.


Mr. Burris pointed out that there has
been a Supreme Court ruling upholding
the contention of the department of
education. This was made in the case
of State vs. O'Dell, 187th Ind., page 84,
in which the attendance law was up-
held.

be re-arrested each day they continue in
business.




