As a matter of fact, the enthusiasm is there. In any campaign for funds, the year I believe it is going to be a tremendous outpouring of genuine community spirit, proof to the world that the people of Indianapolis act together and without stint in matters which concern the community."

If this should come about it will almost surely be through the destructive agents, the use of which we deplore, but of which we make so little effort to control.
