

## HARDING TO ASK VOTE OF CONFIDENCE

the accompanying guarantee, of course, of the United States Treasury. The President was ready to agree to the conclusion of the funding negotiations and the actual receipt of the bonds in this country were so certain as to warrant the Administration making the bonus promise to the former service men. He was fearful some hitch might develop. The contention of Senators that Great Britain alone could be counted on to deliver her bonds and that no more action was necessary in a British Imperial bond backed by the Treasury of the United States, could be offered to American investing capital.

### FIRST PAYMENT EASY ENOUGH.

It was urged that the initial payment, if 80 per cent of the men asked for the cash "bonus," would be \$250,000,000, and that was a sum which could be met easily, although as an added measure of

caution the date of the first payment might be deferred to a more convenient conclusion of funding negotiations. The President considered it unwise to risk the danger of a hitch which might force the Government to disappoint the service men.

Mr. Harding was not outspoken in his opposition to a suggestion that the "bonus" bill carry provision for payment first out of the proceeds to foreign bonds, or from a sales tax. He did not appear that specifically. His position was that the position of a sales tax even though it were to be labeled a "bonus" tax, would be dangerous to Republican success in 1922 congressional elections. Party policy will be determined shortly. Disposal of the Newberry case will be followed by action on the funding bill. The "bonus" legislation will be next.

Party problems in Congress and party

prospects in the by-elections this year will be deferred to some detail at the White House. John T. Adams, chairman of the national committee, was present. It was unnecessary for him to report the popularity of the President and Secretary Hughes over the success of the limitation of armament conference, but a deep disappointment and a positive distrust in Congress. The House discussion revolved rather around the processes of getting better results on Capitol Hill.

CONFERENCE REVEALS SPLIT.

The conversation developed a difference of opinion over the advisability of procedure through party conferences in both House and Senate. Senators Lodge and Brandee were opposed to Senate conferences. They argue such meetings gave malcontents a chance to "buck the traces" and resulted in newspapers reporting lack of party unity. That view was charged by Senators Watson and Curtis, who held the public knew perfectly well there was no party unity in the Senate, but, instead of such agreements taking place in party conferences, they were aired on the Senate floor.

Party conferences, it was contended, would at least develop unity of action among the regular Republicans. It was argued also that as soon as it became known it always was a group of five or six Republicans who were outvoted in their conferences, the public estimate of their course would not be long in establishing itself and the party would be better for it. It would be made clear then, it was contended, that the party majority was striving to make progress in legislation, but that a mere handful were trying to obstruct and delay.
