Union Business Agents Should  
Guard Health of  
Workers.

Unemployment losses due to ill health of building mechanics was the subject of an interesting paper read before several contractors' associations last week by Knickerbocker Boyd of Indianapolis and one of the leading and most maintenance-made by him to the quarterly meeting of the National Board of Industrial Awards in the building industry, just closed in Washington, D. C.

The subject of unemployment losses, due to ill health of building mechanics, should be lower than for indoor workers in other industries, as outdoor occupations are always more conducive to rugged health. He said: "It is better to maintain the health of the workers than to be compelled to give them several days off work because of infirmities of all kinds, including adequate scaffolding, naturally enhance the quality of the work and speed up construction, besides protecting the public and the workers." Speaking of the duties of business agents, a class of men whom he considers the backbone and architect of the Structural Service Bureau of the National Chapter of Architects, Mr. Boyd said: "One of the features of the service given by the business agents of the unions, little known and hence not fully appreciated, is their efforts to see that safety laws and other precautionary measures and regulations protecting quality of work and safety of the worker and public, are lived up to on construction work." To this statement the Marion County Building Trades Council gave its hearty endorsement in addition. "The better class of architects and contractors of our city and county welcome this cooperation." The statement continues, "It may seem like a big task to secure the proper working together of workers, architects and contractors to obtain this ideal coordination, but all parties at interest always did a way."
