LONDON, July 28.—Great Britain may offer to conclude the anti-aggression pact at the conference between Lloyd George and Premier Poincaré, if France will moderate her attitude toward German reparations.

France has long insisted Great Britain to ratify the treaty and Premier Lloyd George, it is believed, now sees an opportunity to offer this guarantee in exchange for an abandonment of French insistence on the indemnity bill.

Great Britain also may insist on a withdrawal of the armies of occupation from the Rhine.

MAY DISMISS JURY

Member Said to Live Across Street From Bombed Home.

CHICAGO, July 28.—The jury in the trial of "Big Tim" Murphy, Fred Mader and "Con" Shee may be dismissed as the result of the discovery Thursday that one of the jurors lives across the street from one of the State's witnesses whose home was bombed.

It took five weeks to secure this jury, and the trial of Chicago labor's "big three" for the murder of Police Lieutenant Lyons is barely under way.
