

DEEP SEA PIRATES CAPTURE VESSEL; HIT SHOAL WATER

Captain Imprisoned by Darling Trio, Who Narrowly Escape Lynching When Caught.

By United News HAMBURG, Oct. 27.—Three deep sea pirates are in the Hamburg jail under close guard to protect them from lynching and the details are just being learned of a stirring episode on blue water. The pirates shot the captain of the schooner Bertha, locked him up, overpowered the crew and took possession of the vessel.

The Bertha, with a valuable cargo, and carrying no arms, was boarded some distance off Hamburg by a party of four men in a small boat. Refusing to surrender at their command, the captain was shot and bungled into his own cabin, where he was locked up. Then the pirates conquered the Bertha's crew and began to ransack the ship.

Having satisfied themselves apparently as to the value of the cargo the pirates began navigating the ship toward shore. Their attention being diverted from the captain he loosed himself and got over the side with some members of his crew in a life-boat and rowed for shore amid the dancing spouts of bullets striking the water all around him. During the night the schooner ran into shoal water and grounded and there she was found when the skipper returned with shipping officials and an armed party from Hamburg. Three pirates remaining aboard were easily taken. The fourth had put off in a small boat and escaped with valuable booty.

When the three prisoners were brought ashore the police had a battle to prevent waterfront crowds from lynching them.


