

MAY MAKE MANY SCHOOL CHANGES

State Board of Education to
Discuss High School Curricula.

When the State board of education meets at the Statehouse within the next three weeks to prepare its legislative program, it will take up two important matters:

A sweeping reorganization of high school studies.

Adoption of new text books suitable to meet the needs of the reorganization and in keeping with the recom-

mendations of the recent educational survey. Under the reorganization, as it is being studied by each individual member of the board, the standard of sixteen units for high school graduation will be upheld with students compelled to take three years of English, three years of social science and two years of mathematics. No science such as chemistry, geography, and botany and no language such as Spanish, French or Latin will be required of the student. Grammar and arithmetic will be stressed in high schools.

In Dublin, were executed at Mount Joy prison today, it was officially announced. Two other insurgent officers were executed at the same time. A master spy of Irish insurgency was known to the Free State government as the man responsible for the death in ambush of Michael Collins and General Ennis. This spy, posing as a chauffeur and machine gunner in the national army, yesterday stole an armored car and handed it over to the rebels.

The armored car was used in a rebel assault at Ballymakeera, County Cork, where 100 Free State troops surrendered to an overwhelming insurgent force after one had been killed and fifteen wounded.

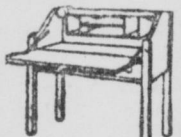

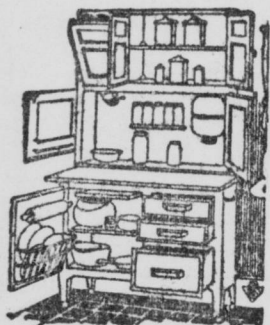
