for \$1,500,000.

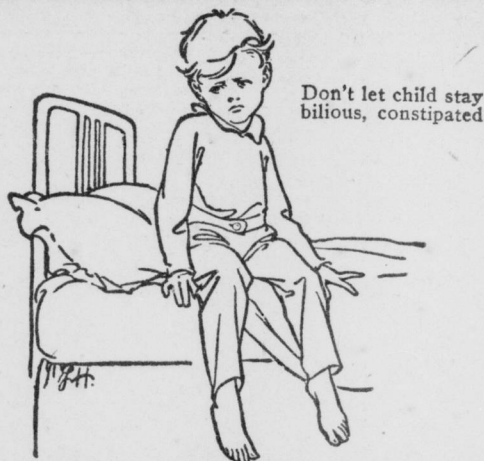
