

**DR. E. J. BULGIN
REVIVAL CAMPAIGN
TO OPEN SUNDAY**

Arrangements Completed for Services at Cadle Tabernacle.

Dr. E. J. Bulgin, evangelist, of Portland, Ore., will arrive in Indianapolis Saturday afternoon to conduct a Community wide campaign, under auspices of the Cadle Tabernacle Evangelistic Association.

Intensive preparations including training of personal workers, special practice of the Gypsy Smith choir, organization of shop meeting specialists have been made for several weeks. Fraternal, industrial and educational programs, together with a constructive plan for publicity have been completed.


