CHARLIE ROBERTSON, the White Sox pitcher who, last summer, flung that famous no-hit, no-run game against the Tigers in Detroit, has signed at last to pitch as many more like it as he can in 1923. Kid Gleason, skipper of the White Sox, made this announcement Tuesday evening as the team entrained at Ft. Worth, Tex., for Shreveport, La., in company with the Giants.

Robertson held out this year for a raise of \$1,000 of the strength not only of his no-hit-no-run game, but his general record for effectiveness throughout the season. In a moment of reckless generosity, Charles Comiskey, owner of the White Sox, offered Charlie a hundred-dollar bonus for the season, or something like \$4 a week, and so Robertson hemmed and Comiskey hewed for these last four months.
