

SCHOOL SHAKE-UP LOOMS AS BOARD TAKES UP CHANGES

Principals May Be Shifted for
Next Year at Meeting
Today.

Numerous changes in assignments of public school principals for next year will be made at a special meeting of the school board Thursday morning. It was predicted today. The instruction committee was scheduled to meet this afternoon to consider recommendations of E. U. Graft, superintendent of schools, for appointments of principals, supervisors and executive employees.

According to stories in circulation, there will be a general shake-up among the principals, and a number who have been assigned to choice buildings will be relegated to less desirable ones.

Teachers Appointed

With the exception of the special list, which will be taken up at the committee meeting today, all appointments to the teaching staff grade and high schools were made by the board Tuesday night. In every instance recommendations of E. U. Graft, superintendent of schools, for appointments of principals, supervisors and executive employees.

Two rules which will fall heavily on a number of teachers were adopted. One provided that women who are mothers of young children and who are living with their husbands shall not be employed as teachers. The other provided that teachers affected with poor eyesight or hearing should undergo physical examinations. In the event the troubles are found to be progressive, time will be given them to prepare for other work.

Some of the oldest teachers in the city in point of service will be affected by the latter rule, it was said.

Dr. Hasley Favorable

Women who have no sufficient interest in their own children to stay home and take care of them can have only a financial interest in teaching and is not the person to have charge of other women's children." Dr. Marie Hasley, president of the board, said in speaking in favor of the first resolution.

A strenuous protest against establishment of the Florence Crittenton Home in the neighborhood of School No. 32, Illinois and Twenty-First Sts. was entered by teachers of the school in a letter to the board.

The board ordered Frank B. Ross, attorney for the board, and Richard O. Johnson, business director, to protest to the proper persons against establishment of the home, and to see what steps could be taken to prevent it.

Frank Owens, 322 Ellsworth St., received slight burns on the hands when a solution he was using in a washing machine at the Franco-American Cleaners, 2935 Central Ave., exploded. This is the second explosion that has occurred at this place recently.
