

SAMUEL VAN CAMP WILL BE LAID TO FINAL REST HERE

Rites Saturday for Member of
Iron Firm, Who Died in
New York.

The Rev. Jean S. Milner, pastor of
the Second Presbyterian Church, will
conduct funeral services of Samuel
G. Van Camp, 45, of 1142 N. Penn-
sylvania st., who died in New York
Thursday, at the residence Saturday
at 2:30 p. m. Private burial in Crown
Hill.

Mr. Van Camp, a vice president of

the Van Camp Hardware and Iron
Company, was a son of Cortland Van
Camp, a founder of the company. He
had been a semi-invalid since he
suffered a stroke of apoplexy six
years ago. He had spent last winter
in Florida. He went to Paris with
his wife and daughter, Lillian May
Van Camp, to consult a specialist
and was returning home when death
occurred.

Raymond P. Van Camp, a brother,
was expected in Indianapolis today
with the body.
Mr. Van Camp is survived by the
widow and daughter, his parents, Mr.
and Mrs. Cortland Van Camp, and a
sister, Mrs. John T. Martindale. A
son, Cortland Van Camp III, was
drowned in an automobile accident at
Fall creek last winter.

Mr. Van Camp, who was born in
Indianapolis, was a graduate of
Shortridge High School. He attended
Andover College, after which he be-
came active in his father's firm.

Mr. Van Camp was affiliated with
the University, Columbia, Country,
Woodstock and Dramatic Clubs, the
Indianapolis Chamber of Commerce
and the Second Presbyterian Church.
