

I. W. W. INVASION OF TEXAS CANCELLED

Leaders Order Mobilization of Forces Called Off.

PORT ARTHUR, Texas, July 20.—The I. W. W. invasion of Port Arthur is off. Orders for the mobilization of forces in half a dozen States have been cancelled by leaders of the organization. Those en route to Port Arthur have been ordered back to their posts.
Switch in orders has been made because of a general strike call, declared Sidney Terry, I. W. W. organizer, awaiting trial today with three companions on a charge of vagrancy.
Terry said a general strike of International Marine Transport Workers is to be ordered to protest the sentence of twenty-seven members at Los Angeles a week ago and a court injunction making membership in the I. W. W. organization punishable by imprisonment.

PREMIUM ON BOND SHORT

Trust Company Makes Quick Payment of Roy Couch Forfeit.

Payment by the Fidelity and Deposit Company of Maryland of \$9,771.47 to the State for shortage in the funds of Roy Couch, ousted State-house custodian, revealed the fact that Couch had not even paid all the premium due on his bond of office, it was learned today.

In spite of the fact that the company was a total loser on Couch's bond, a check for the amount was turned over to Lawrence F. Orr, chief examiner of the State board of accounts. Orr said it was the quickest settlement in the history of the office.
