

# Evans and Gardner Battle for Title—New York Yankees Far Out in Front

## WESTERN CHAMP DEFENDS CROWN IN FINAL MATCH

Chick Downs Sweetser in Thrilling Extra-Hole Play in Semi-Finals.

**CLEVELAND**, July 28.—Chick Evans, the defending Western amateur champion, and Hamilton Gardner of Buffalo met today for the title at the Mayfield Country Club here. Evans went to the finals by his great victory Friday over the national amateur champ, Jess Sweetser, in a 38-hole match.

Gardner earned his chance at the title by his defeat of Joe Wells of East Liverpool, Ohio, 4 and 3 in a fine match Friday that was almost forgotten because of the prominence of the two stars which were fighting it out in the other half of the bracket. The course was soaked today following an all-night rain.

Evans and Sweetser fought it out through the day Friday in a see-saw struggle that ended only after two extra holes had been played.

Sweetser lost his chance to halve the thirty-eighth hole when he missed a short putt.
