

BULLET-RIDDLED CAR IS LOCATED

Sheriff Finds Moving Target
of Former Raid.

A Nash touring car with bullet holes through a fender, body and gasoline tank is in possession of Sheriff George Snider. The officer found the car hidden in woods at Hammond's Grove, a mile and a half up the river from Liberty Beach, Sunday night while on a raid, he said.

"The car is the one we chased six miles last week when it drove up during our raid on a still at Traders Point," said the sheriff. "The certificate of title gives the owner's name as C. C. McCutcheon, 226 S. Illinois St., but I haven't been able to get in touch with him."

A gallon of whisky found buried in the woods was dug up by Snider. Abatement proceedings to close the camp will be urged on the prosecutor, the sheriff said. No arrests were made, as the liquor was not in a building.

Word that the sheriff was "out along the river" was passed down the line, he said, and a quiet evening was passed by all the camps, visitors to Liberty Beach being greeted with strains from a victoria, instead of an orchestra.

INVESTIGATION OF VALUATION ASKED

Groninger Wants New Figures
in Gas Case.

Investigation of valuation of the Citizens Gas Company property on the basis of original cost and money expended for improvements is asked in a letter to the Indiana public service commission from Taylor Groninger, city corporation counsel. The figures will be used in arguments in the gas rate case.

Groninger's letter followed receipt from Earl Carter, public service commission engineer, of appraisal of the company as of Jan. 1, 1923, based on a ten-year period, 1912-22.

The city has requested the original cost of operative property as calculated by State engineers, and actual investment as shown by State accountants.

Groninger pointed out that the reproduction theory was not considered "fair value" in such states as New York, Illinois, Michigan, Wisconsin, California, Kansas, Massachusetts, Oregon and Georgia.
