PENNSY MEN TEST HIGH

Examinations Show Many Employees 99 Per Cent Efficient.

How train accidents caused by "man failures" are prevented on the Pennsylvania Railroad System is shown in a report just compiled by the chief of transportation, according to word re-

ceived by local Pennsy officials. The report covers "efficiency" tests to determine whether employees engaged in train movement are properly observing signals, operating rules and other safety precautions. Results of these tests show as high as 99.9 per cent efficiency on the part of employees.

Under the plan in effect on the Pennsylvania, thousands of these tests are made every month. During the

month of December, the latest for which figures are available, more than 62,000 individual tests were conducted in the four operating regions of the system. In November, 68,000 were made. The purpose of these tests is to insure as far as possible the actual observance of safety rules and devices by the men in charge of trains while they are out on the road.
