

BEST ROUTES TO URBANA AND OTHER GAMES ARE GIVEN

Hoosier Motor Club Aids Football Fans Who Wish to Go by Auto.

Motoring to football games is the favorite outdoor sport in October, according to the touring department of the Hoosier Motor Club. Hundreds have signified their intention of motorizing to Urbana, Ill., to see Red Grange in action against De Pauw next Saturday. Many other requests for touring information are coming into the club from football fans who desire to see their favorite teams in action. Best routes for Saturday's football games are given by the Hoosier Motor Club as follows:

TO URBANA—Leave Indianapolis via Indiana Ave. and follow State Rd. 6 to Lebanon; from Lebanon go west on State Rd. 33 through Crawfordsville to the Indiana-Illinois State line; from the State line follow Illinois State Rd. 19 through Danville to Urbana. The road is paved from Indianapolis to Lebanon, then gravel to the State line. From the State line to Urbana the road is paved. Distance, 123 miles.

TO FRANKFURT—Go south on Meridian St. under the Union Station subway and angle left where the street forks (Madison Ave.). Go south on Madison Ave. and follow State Rd. 1 to Franklin. The road is paved. Distance, 21 miles.

TO RICHMOND—Go east on Washington St. and follow the National Old Trails Rd. (State Rd. 3) through Greensburg and Knightstown to Richmond. The road is paved excepting a short grade separation at Dunreith. Caution for bridge in Cambridge City. Distance is sixty-seven miles.

TO VALPARAISO—Leave Indianapolis via Indiana Ave. and follow State Rd. 6 to Lebanon; from Lebanon go north on State Rd. 44 through Frankfort and Deloit to Monticello; from Monticello go west on State Rd. 7 to Reynolds; from Reynolds go north on the Monon Way to Wansah. Caution for numerous railroad crossings. From Wansah follow State Rd. 2 west to Valparaiso. The road is paved from Indianapolis to Lebanon; from Lebanon to Valparaiso is principally gravel. Distance is 149 miles.

TO OAKLAND CITY—Leave Indianapolis via W. Washington St. at the edge of the city, where the road forks, angle left and follow the National Old Trails Rd. through Brazil to Terre Haute. Caution for one-way bridge at Putnamville and narrow grade three miles east of Terre Haute. Distance is 70 miles.

Strife Must End for All Time, He Declares.

PEKIN, Oct. 24.—"The greatest crime in modern times was the intrigue, that caused the present war in northern China," Feng Yu Hsiang, famed Christian general, whose 10,000 fighting men, the best in China held the capital today, said in an interview with the United Press.

"Leaders in China have decided war must end for all time. That's why we have acted and seized the city."

"China has been made a shell which all men must now try to piece together and support. I believe public opinion will back us up in this."

"It is criminal of Wu Pei Fu to send half clad, half starved soldiers in no condition for warfare to fight against the Manchurians."

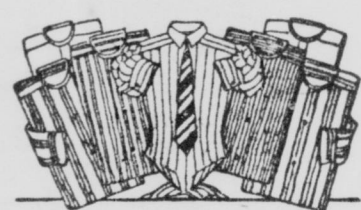

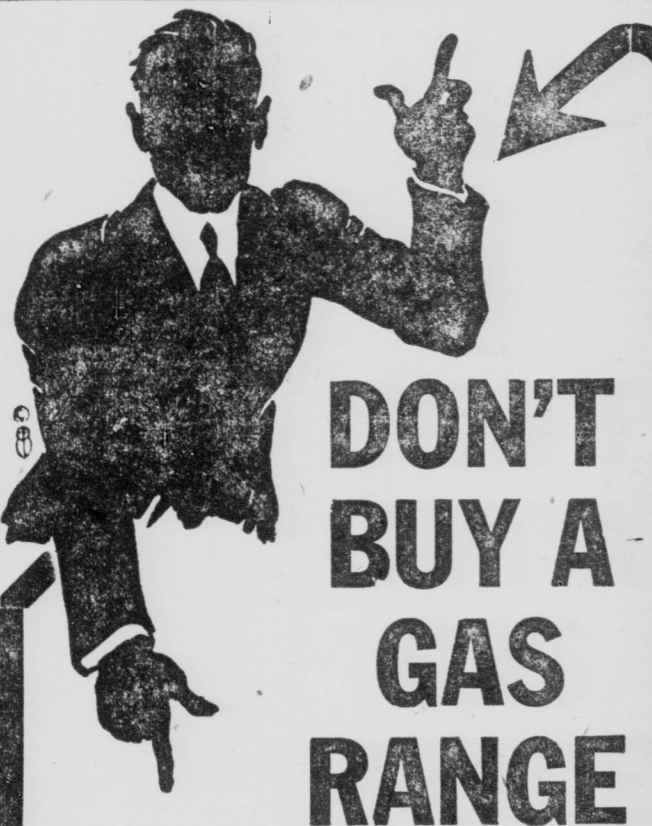
