URBANA AND OTHER
GAMES ARE GIVEN**

Hoosier Motor Club Aids
Football Fans Who Wish
to Go by Auto.

Motoring to football games is the favorite outdoor sport in October, according to the touring department of the Hoosier Motor Club. Hundreds have signified their intention of motoring to Urbana, Ill., to see Red Grange in action against De Paul next Saturday. Many other requests for touring information are coming into the club from football fans who desire to see their favorite teams in action. Best routes for Saturday's football games are given by the Hoosier Motor Club as follows:

TO URBANA—Leave Indianapolis via Indiana Ave. and follow State Rd. 6 to Lebanon; from Lebanon go west on State Rd. 43 through Greenfield, and Indiana-Delaware State line, from the State line follow Illinois State Rd. 10 through Danville to Urbana. Total distance 120 miles. From Lebanon then travel to the State line. From the State line to Urbana the road is paved. Distance 12 miles.

TO FRANKLIN—Go south on Meridian St. under the Union Station bridge, and angle left where the street forks (Madison Ave.) Go south on Madison Ave. and follow State Rd. 10 through Franklin. The road is paved. Distance 21 miles.

TO RICHMOND—Follow Washington St. and follow the National Old Trails Rd. (State Rd. 31) through Greenfield and Knightstown to New Haven. From New Haven follow short grade separation at Dunreath. Caution for bridge in Cambridge City. Distance 12 miles.

TO VALPARAISO—Leave Indianapolis via Indiana Ave. and follow State Rd. 43 through Frankfort and Delphi to Monticello; from Monticello angle left and follow State Rd. 43 north to Wabash. Caution for narrow road. From Wabash follow State Rd. 3 west to Valparaiso. The road is paved from Indianapolis to Lebanon, and then gravel. Distance is 149 miles.

TO OAKLAND CITY—Leave Indianapolis via W. Washington St. at the edge of the city, where the road forks, angle left and follow the National Old Trails Rd. through Brady to Terre Haute. The road is paved throughout. Caution for one-way bridge at Putnamville. Distance 70 miles.

SAYS WAR CRIME**

Strike Must End for All
Time, He Declares.

PEKIN, Oct. 24.—"The greatest crime in modern times was the intrigue, that caused the present war in northern China," Feng Yu Hsiang, famed Christian general whose 10,000 fighting men, the best in China hold the capital today, said in an interview with the United Press.

"Leaders in China have decided war must end for all time. That's why we have acted and seized the city."

"China has been made shell which all men must now try to piece together and support. I believe public opinion will back us up in this."

"It is criminal of Wu Pei Fu to send half clad, half starved soldiers in no condition for warfare to fight against the Manchurians."




