Whether Shelby St. will be opened under proposed elevation of the Pennsylvania tracks on the east side, is now in the hands of the committees.

Then there are committees of one. That's the favorite sport of the board of safety. Police Chief Herman F. Rikhoff, Fire Chief John J. O'Brien and John Berry, city electrician, have been on so many committees in investigations that they can't look a committee in the face.

Committees for Holidays

Every time Mayor Shank wants to proclaim a holiday, for Candy day, or Get-Out-of-Debt day, James M. Ogden, corporation counsel, is the committee announcing it to the public.

Last, but not least, comes the city council committees, so numerous that no councilman presumes to even guess how many he is on.






