BASSLER HOMESouvenir Hunters Flock to
Scene of Tragedy.By United Press
LOGANSPORT, Ind., Jan. 2.—A
guard stood watch over the Bassler
murder house near here to prevent
morbid souvenir hunters from literally
tearing it down in the quest for
memorabilia of the gruesome crime.Hundreds of persons braved the
cold of New Year's day to drive to
the Bassler farm, but they were kept
from carrying away souvenirs by the
guard, which is maintained day and
night.Bodies of the four victims, Mr. and
Mrs. Henry Bassler, John Bassler
and Iola Hobough, were buried in
adjoining graves in the cemetery at
the Matae Baptist Church Thursday
afternoon. More than a thousand
persons attended.The Rev. H. D. Trickey prayed for
forgiveness for Mrs. Emma Hobough,
who confessed the killings. "She knew not what she did," the
Rev. Trickey said.Mrs. Hobough is now confined in
the Northern Hospital for the Insane
and next week the Cass County
grand jury will begin an investigation
of the killings.


