

FIRMS IN RECEIVERSHIP

Control Granted Over Ohio Companies Headed by Hawkins.

DAYTON, Ohio, Jan. 15.—Ralph E. Hoskett today assumed receivership of the Welfare Loan Companies at Columbus, Cincinnati, Lancaster and Dayton, of which Morton Hawkins, of the bankrupt Hawkins Mortgaging Company of Portland, Ind., is president.

Hoskett was appointed on petition of Sarah G. Fulton of Portland, as a stockholder, owning one \$50 share. She also asks for an injunction preventing officers of the company from interfering with company property, or allowing any person to vote any common stock of the company unless an election is legally called.
