

**LONG LEGS AND
RED HAIR WILL
GET BRAIN TEST**

University of Chicago to
Conduct Experiments on
College Students.

CHICAGO, April 3.—If long legs
and red hair are a proof of brains,
the University of Chicago is going
to find it out.

Dr. William H. Sheldon, psychogist, is testing out the theory ad-
vanced by Professor Naccarati of Co-
lumbia that the long legged man has
the greatest brain capacity. He will
examine, measure and test 400 fra-
ternity men at the university for
length of arms and legs, width of
shoulders and the color of the skin,
the hair and the eyes.

He will grade his subjects as to
scholastic ability, ability to pass in-
telligence tests, and social adap-
tability. He will then compare the physical

and the mental figures and will for
the first time find out scientifically
whether the man with a fine phys-
ique makes the best showing so-
cially.






